English

Children's writing this term will be inspired by our theme, including Wallace and Gromit's Cracking Contraptions We will be writing stories, letters, recounts and reports.

Keys skills will include:

- Correct use of apostrophes
- Using a range of conjunctions in our writing
- Developing stamina to write longer pieces with paragraphs

Maths

This term we will be mastering our knowledge of:

- Measurement—Money
- Measurement Capacity and Temperature
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and Division (2s, 5s and 10s)

Science

This term, we will become biologists focussing on the study of plants. We will be learning:

- To name and sort different types of trees
- To recognise changes to deciduous trees through the seasons
- To name and describe the conditions needed for a plant to grow
- To observe and compare changes to a plant over time
- To describe the stages of the lifecycle of a sunflower

Art

In Art, we will become printers! This will include exploring hand and finger printing and

then designing and creating our own stamps. We will also create polystyrene tiles to print with, focussing on producing a clean printed

In Computing, we will be learning to:

- Create Pictures

Geography

In Geography, we will be finding out about hot and cold areas in the world. We will learn:

- To locate the Equator, Northern and Southern Hemispheres, North Pole and South Pole
- To locate and name countries within climate zones

DT

In DT, our focus will be Mechanics. We will be designing and creating products using levers and winding mechanisms.

Music

In Music, we will be looking at the song 'Friendship Song' by Joanna Mangona and Pete Readman, As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song we will also listen to and appraise other songs about friendship as well as performing and composing using glockenspiels and voices.
