**Intent:** Reading sits at the heart of our school. We want all pupils to read a variety of authors and for pupils to have access to a range of rich, quality texts written by a selection of authors, which will inspire them to love reading.

Reading opens the door to wider learning and we are passionate that all pupils succeed through reading. Our aim is for all pupils to become confident and fluent readers.

Implementation: These texts have been chosen specifically for each year group, so that pupils at our school experience a broad and balanced reading curriculum. Over their time at Kingsway, they will experience a wide reading curriculum, which values established as well as modern authors. Texts are progressive from nursery through to year six.

We have mapped out class readers, which are instrumental in creating a passion and love of reading alongside texts that drive our curriculum lessons in English.
