Impressive results

Our results have been impressive yet again right from Reception to Year 6. Last year, our school was in the highest 20% for progress in all areas; this year our Y6 Greater Depth standard is almost 3 times that of national: 19% combined achieve the highest standard in all 3 areas combined, compared to 7% nationally. Wow, what a testament the quality of teaching at our school and the dedication and drive of our children.

A new standard in Y6 performance

Parents were in awe of the quality of the Y6 production with many comments that it was the best ever seen and set a new standard; a standing ovation from the crowd was a fitting end to the final performance yesterday! The children performed superbly in every role with some notable performances from children destined for the stage. Huge thanks to every one of the staff for their tireless efforts in putting the show together.

GSSN Quick stick Hockey Competition

We hope that the Rainbow Dash will be able to happen again in 2024, so keep an eye out and book your space!!



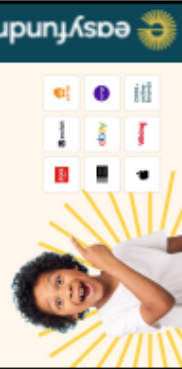
When the sun is out in the final half term of the school year, the ice creams and ice lollies make an appearance after school.
