Raiders and Invaders!

History/Geography

We will become historians and discover when and why the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings invaded Britain. Our learning will discover how this period of history links to other periods such as the Bronze and Stone Age. Discover what life was like in an Anglo-Saxon village and investigate what jobs people did in the Anglo-Saxon and Viking periods and how these events shaped our lives today.

Use your geographical knowledge to find out where these fierce warriors came from. Use an atlas to locate countries, cities and counties. Find out where in the world Gloucestershire is and practise geographical skills like locating countries, lines of latitude and longitude.

Design, Technology and Art

Become a clay sculptor! Make a replica of the famous Sutton Hoo Hoard. Make observational sketches using 3D effects such as shading and hatching.

Develop an electrical system as part of our designs to make a handheld light source to explore an historical site.

Music

Ahoy, me hearties! We will be listening to, composing and performing our very own Sea Shanties! We will have 10 lessons of whole class clarinet, which is so exciting!

PSHE/RSE

Learn how to develop caring and trusting relationships with friends and family - know what a healthy relationship is.

Understand the life cycle of humans and how our bodies change.



Year 4 are learning about the development of British History from Anglo Saxon Britain to the Vikings.



English

We will create our own stories based on the exciting book: The Train to Impossible Places, create our own version of Beowulf, create non-chronological reports about the Anglo-Saxons, and write letters.

Maths

Decimals and fractions will be our first focus. Do you know your 2D and 3D shapes? How many edges does a tetrahedron have? Learn to describe the properties of shapes and find and measure angles. How far? We will learn to calculate perimeter of shapes and end with a bit of statistics!

<u>Science</u>

Electrifying electricity and exciting experiments! We will learn how to draw and build electrical circuits. Then we will be investigating how sound travels, what makes sounds louder or quieter and how we hear sounds. Discover how your ear works and understand vibrations, pitch and amplitude.

Religious Education

Physical Education

This term we will be developing our striking and fielding skills with learning to play cricket and rounders. Get ready to be an athlete and prepare our athletic ability including preparation for sports day! Finally, we will learn to invade in sports by learning to play netball.

During our Teach Computing lessons we will learn to be programmers! We will learn how to programme repeating shapes and then how to programme a repeating game.
