Then we went to Horsens event center to spend some fun, active and pleasant hours with all Danish colleagues at:


- Human tabletop football


Start of hunting season for elk in south of Sweden

Every year the hunting season for elk starts second Monday of October in south of Sweden. So next week the hunting will start to help reduce traffic accidents.

Every year there are around $5\,000 - 6\,000$ car accidents with elk and in total about $45\,000$ accidents with wild animals in Sweden. About 800 people don't survive an accident with an elk every year.

Everyone that has plenty of traveling time in a car knows about this risk and luckily we have not had any bad accidents at Amada Sweden yet this year.


IT Department - iPad Sales App

Originally developed as a kiosk application for use at the opening of the refurbished UK Technical Centre, it has been expanded to provide a comprehensive solution for the distribution and presentation of sales collateral. There are tailored versions available for the UK Spain and the Nordics.



A self-contained App, it can run without connection to the internet to demonstrate the capabilities of our machines, tooling, software and services. It includes a comprehensive image library of installations that can be filtered by location, industry, application and type of machine.

Generally available marketing documents can be opened and viewed as well as secured company confidential documents such as Machine Layouts, Installation Requirements and Schedules.



The app continues to be enhanced to meet the sales team's changing needs, an example being the recent addition of interactive Feed Rate Comparisons. Similar Apps have been developed in other regions, however The Northern Europe app is widely recognised as the class leader.
