

How have European political groups voted on LGBTI rights in 2019-2024?

Between 2019 and 2024, the European Parliament consistently promoted the rights of LGBTIQ+ people. Among hundreds of votes on LGBTIQ+ rights across 5 years, we picked 8 roll-call votes that give a broad idea of how political groups stand on LGBTIQ+ issues.

Below are results of votes by political group on a selection of important LGBTIQ+ EP resolutions during previous term. Data is from database <u>assistEU</u>.
