Day of arrival (please see enclosed information on travel to and in Stockholm). Welcome desk in the hotel lobby of Mornington Hotel, from 7.00 PM. Informal dinner (self-paid) at Mornington Hotel.

Thursday 31st of August

09.15 AM Meeting point Mornington Hotel. Slow walk to the Cavalry Barracks. (Dress code: casual / blazer)

Visiting the Royal Dragoon Guards Regiment, guided by Inspector of Music, Lieutenant-colonel Olof Hermansen.

10.00-10.45 AM Introduction and guided tour of the barracks of the Dragoon Guards by Captain Göran Mellblom and Lieutenant-colonel Olof Hermansen.

10.45-11.35 AM Following the Band of the Dragoon Guards (Livgardets

Dragonmusikkår) and the Dragoon Guards preparing and march-off for the mounted march through the central city of Stockholm, from the barracks to the Royal Palace - "Den beridna högvakten".

11.35-12.30 AM Lunch at the all ranks dining hall and guided tour through the stables of the Dragoon Guards.

12.30-1.15 PM Transport (walk or city bus No. 54) to the Royal Mews.

1.15 PM Meeting point in front of the Royal Dramatic Theatre (Dramaten).

1.30-2.30 PM Introduction and guided tour of the Royal Mews with the Royal coaches by the Equerry to His Majesty the King, Ulf Gunnehed, and by the Master of horses to the His Majesty the King, Lars-Olof Nilsson.

1.30-2.10 PM Lunch at the Royal Army Museum.

2.15-3.25 PM IMMS Annual Gathering Meeting, in the conference room at the Royal Army Museum. Meeting Chairman: Kris Schauvliege, Belgium/Luxembourg. 3.25-3.45 PM Coffee-break.

3.45-4.00 PM Presentation about the Swedish Military Music Society.

4.00-5.00 PM Presentation of the Royal Army Museum, by the 1st Intendant of the Royal Army Museum, Thomas Roth, and free time (with his guidance) in the Royal Army Museum.

2.00-3.30 PM Guided tour by bus (parked by the Obelisk), ending at the Royal Palace of Drottningholm. Free time in the Palace gardens, visit the Palace Theatre (conserved since 1790) or a self-paid guided tour in the Palace (between 4.00-4.45 PM, SEK 130). 4.50 PM Meeting point at the pier by the steam boats.

5.00-6.00 Evening journey by steamer from the Royal Palace of Drottningholm back to the city of Stockholm / City Town Hall quay.

6.10 PM Kiss and cry. Some of the IMMS-members will leave the group, because of early morning flights.

Evening at your disposal (food self-paid).

Sunday 3rd of September

Departure day. Opportunity to visit the Vasa-Museum or the ABBA Museum, self-paid.
