THANKSGIVING

Thanksgiving is a national holiday in the United States. It is celebrated on the 4th Thursday of November. On Thanksgiving many Americans celebrate with friends and family. They eat Thanksgiving dinner and share what they are most thankful for from the previous year.

Thanksgiving History

In 1620, a group of pilgrims left England on a ship called the Mayflower. They left because they wanted religious freedom and a new home. They went to America. In America, the Native Americans were friendly and helpful. They taught the pilgrims how to hunt and grow crops. In 1621, the Native Americans and the pilgrims shared a fall harvest feast. A feast is a large and special meal. This feast is believed to be the first Thanksgiving. However, the peace did not last. Years later, the pilgrims killed the Native Americans and took their land. Thus, Thanksgiving is also considered by some to be a national day of mourning.

Thanksgiving Dinner

On Thanksgiving many Americans still share a large and special dinner. They eat roasted turkey with mashed potatoes, stuffing, corn, cranberry sauce, and pumpkin pie. When making the dinner, they use foods native to America.

Thanksgiving Parades

Many Americans also watch the Thanksgiving parades. The Marcy's Thanksgiving Day Parade in New York City is the world's largest parade. The parades have fun balloons, marching bands, and parade floats.
