

JRC Petten vs EGC Challenge

Sluispolder, Friday 15 July 2016

This year was the 31st time JRC Petten and EGC had contested the *Derek Perry Memorial Plate*. The Challenge, started in 1986 had, until 2015, been won 16 times by Petten, 14 times by EGC.

In 2015 JRC Petten was only able to field 2 players and it was agreed that, for future Challenges, a minimum of 5 players per team would be required. Happily, JRC Petten was able to field a group of eight players this year though four did not have a proper EGA handicap. It was agreed that these four would play off an exact handicap of 36.0. EGC put out a group of 10 players.

This 31st Challenge, at the Sluispolder course just north of Alkmaar, was played in good golfing conditions, partly sunny with a temperature of ~18C but with a freshening breeze during the latter stages.

Individual scores are given in the table below, with EGC winning the Challenge by 155 points to 140.
