## **Chaturvedi Veterans Tournament 2017.**

The fifth Chaturvedi Veterans Tournament was held over two days, Tuesday 6 and Thursday 8 June, on the ESTEC course. As usual the format was medal stroke play with handicap adjustment, the winner scoring the lowest net total over the 36 holes. Fourteen players competed over both rounds, but the field this year was lower than usual due to injury, illness or other unforeseen events.

The weather Gods were certainly unkind on the first day with a near gale-force wind though the expected rain didn't materialise. Thankfully the weather on day two was much kinder with largely blue skies and a moderate breeze. The average of the players' Stableford points was up 3.5 compared with day one.

Given the conditions, Peter Behrmann scored a magnificent net 55 strokes (39 Stb points) on day one and went into day two with a lead of eight strokes over his nearest challenger Tony van Rosmalen. Wil Spangenberg led the charge on day two scoring net 58 (36 Stb points). However the final result was hardly in doubt, Peter winning with a total of 117 strokes. Second was Tony with 129 strokes and third Wil with 131 strokes. Other scores below:
