Below are 'The Important Things' I need to mention this month. Also you will find the details you need to renew your membership, if you haven't renewed already.

Remember you have to have renewed both your club and BMFA membership before flying in 2024. Don't forget your CAA registration and to sticker each model that you fly.



1. Club Get together.

The Tuesday February 20th get together has been designated as a 'Bring and Buy evening'. Bring along anything you might want to sell and some cash just in case anybody brings along anything you fancy.. from a bag of screws or a couple of servos to that old war bird gathering dust in the loft. Arrival from 7pm. Note: Although designated as a 'bring and buy' evening, it is still primarily a get together so if you can, please do come. It would be great to see you there.

2. Membership

Paul, our membership secretary, has reported strong renewal numbers with just a few confirmed non-re-joiners (which has been mainly due to ill health.) If you are one of those members, the clubs thought are with you, please do keep in touch.

The committee further confirm that, based on current flying site utilisation and renewal numbers, we are currently open to new members. If you have any interested friends or relatives, please do try and get them to visit the site for a chat.

3. ** IMPORTANT ** Please use the windsock at all times..

There has been an Airprox report doing the rounds at the BMFA recently and a copy was also sent to the committee. I will hopefully report on this more fully in the next use letter, but Basically an AIRPROX is a situation where the distance between aircraft and their relative positions and speed are such that safety may be compromised.

The Airprox being discussed was a situation where a group of full size aircraft, namely the RAF red arrows display team flew across a location were model aeroplanes were flying which resulted in an Airprox situation.

Nobody was hurt and, in actual fact the red arrows display team didn't even know that the situation had occurred but the committee having discussed this issue suggest that one thing we should do is...

WHENEVER YOU ARE FLYING AT THE FIELD PUT THE WIND SOCK UP.

The idea behind this is, that the wind-sock would be visible to (most) full size aircraft if they over fly our site at low levels, giving them some warning that we are there. Please do this even if there is no wind and the sock is not strictly necessary for our activities.

4. And finally...

As a new flying season begins please do let the committee know of anything you would like to see happen within the club during the year, training, certification, perhaps a trip somewhere? Let us know and we will see what we can do!
