WHY enter the Koestler awards?

We give over **1,000** awards a year. Every entrant gets a participation certificate. Most winners get a cash prize. The total prize money is over £30,000.

The awards available in most artforms are:

Outstanding: £100 + gilted certificate

1st prize: £60 + embossed certificate

2nd prize £40 + embossed certificate

3rd prize: £30 + embossed certificate

Merit: £20 + embossed certificate

Under 18s and Over 50s

Highly Commended embossed certificate

Commended certificate

- Entries are judged by over 60 experts from different fields, who send brief written feedback to as many entrants as possible.
- We display a selection of the entries at our annual national exhibition (which had 9,000 visitors in 2007) and at other venues during the year.
- In visual arts and crafts, we can try to sell your work on your behalf.
- We may reproduce your work on our website, merchandise or publications: we will send you copies if we do.
- If you show strong artistic talent and are due for release in the next 3 years, we may allocate a professional artist to mentor you to carry on your arts activity in the community.

WHO can enter?

- Any current inmate of a UK prison, Young Offender Institution, Secure Children's Home, Immigration Removal Centre or High or Medium Security Psychiatric Hospital or Unit (including the Channel Islands and Isle of Man).
- Any current client of the Probation Service, a Youth Offending Team, the Scottish Criminal Justice Social Work Service or their equivalents elsewhere in the British Isles.
- Any UK citizen currently in a prison overseas (for whom there are special awards sponsored by Prisoners Abroad).
- You may enter as an individual or as a group.

WHAT can I enter?

- * You can enter original work in any of the artforms listed in this guidance.
- The work must be from the last 12 months.
- Up to 5 entries per person or group. Attach one entry form to every entry.

HOW do I enter?

- Fill in one entry form for each entry. You are welcome to photocopy the form.
- Ask a member of staff to sign each form and give their contact details. We cannot accept your entry if it is not signed by a member of staff.
- Pack your work carefully so that it reaches us safely. Very large, heavy, fragile or valuable items should be delivered and collected by hand: please ring us to discuss. Many establishments send a van of entries each year: ask if this happens at your establishment.
- In artforms marked of you can enter by sending photographs and notes.

WHEN is do I have to enter and when will I hear back?

End December 2008	All entries returned, except a selection for further exhibition or sale until Sept 2009: we will tell you if your work is selected.
March 2009 Sept 2009	Deadline for 2009 Awards Return of any unsold or further exhibited entries from 2008
