



From Malmö to Stockholm – Swedish Royal Tour

With the birth of little Estelle the future queen of Sweden, royal family became more popular than ever. So let us offer you the tour, which will allow you to visit most magnificent royal places and manors. This trip is very interesting from the historical point of view and very romantic at the same time.

Place: trip to the royal castles and manors with the accommodation in some of them

Start / End: Malmö / Stockholm

Duration: 5-7 days

Day 1. Castles and manors of Southern Sweden

A millennium of royal history has left Skåne with an impressive legacy of historic buildings. Many of these impressive buildings, once reserved for the nobility alone, are now open to the public as museums or just for a stroll in the castle park. We recommend you spend some time just driving along the winding roads, soaking in the beauty of the landscape and stopping as you please at the many fascinating castles, like Sofiero Castle, which was voted “Best Park in Europe 2010” and used to be the Royal Family's summer home.

Stay at: Häckeberga Castle

Driving time from Malmö Airport: 15 min



Day 2. Kalmar Slott

The history of the legendary Kalmar Castle stretches back over 800 years, with it serving as protection from both pirates and the Danes. It is now a popular landmark and destination.

Stay at: Möckelsnäs Manor

Drive from previous night's hotel: 1.5 hours



Day 3. Läckö Slott

The fairy tale-like Läckö Castle is a magnificent castle on the shores of Lake Vänern, and was built in the 13th century. If you want to explore the city of Gothenburg, you are now just one hour away.

Stay at: Bjertorp Castle

Drive from previous night's hotel: 4 hours

Day 4. Örebro Slott

Many parts of Swedish history are connected with Örebro Castle, which was built more than 700 years ago. This mighty fortress, situated in the middle of Örebro, in old times created a scene for many historical events.

Stay at: Kohlswa Herrgård

Drive from previous night's hotel: 3 hours

Days 5 – 7. Stockholm

For natural reasons, most palaces, castles and manors are largely concentrated around the areas surrounding the Royal Capital: Lake Mälaren, Uppland & Stockholm. Drive along the areas as you please, pick one of our hotels that tickles your imagination to stay at and spend



some time in the Royal Capital to visit the homes of the Royal Family, including the palaces of Drottningholm, Haga and Stockholm.

Our guides based in Stockholm can always meet you at Drottningholm palace, Royal Palace in the Old Town, Skokloster and Gripsholm Palaces, or other part of the town and to give you an interesting guided tour.

Stay at: Sundbyholm Castle, Yxtaholm Castle, Gimo Manor, Söderfors Manor or Kohlswa Manor.

Driving time from the previous night's hotel: 3-5 hours

Driving time to Stockholm Arlanda Airport is 20-60 minutes
