



Guided City Tours. Bergen.

Walking guided tours 2 – 3 hours.

City center guided tour (2 hours)

Guided tour includes St. Mary's Church, Hanseatic seafront Bryggen, the residence of King Håkan, Rosenkrantz tower, open fish market and central square – Torgallmeningen. You will learn a lot about the history of the city and the Hanseatic League..

City Guided tour with the visit to Hanseatic museum and Floibanen (3 hours)

Guided city tour with the visit to Hanseatic museum and Floibanen (3 hours)

Guided tour includes St. Mary's Church, Hanseatic seafront Bryggen, the residence of King Håkan, Rosenkrantz tower, open fish market and central square – Torgallmeningen. You will learn a lot about the history of the city and the Hanseatic League.

Hanseatic Museum: is situated in the house of Hanseatic League merchant built in the 18th century. Original interior will show the life and work of German merchants in Bryggen during the times of the League. The museum is open daily 10:00-17:00 (June - August).

Floibanen: is a cable-railway which leads up the Floi mountain. There is a nice view over the city and sea from the 320 m. Open daily 9:00-24:00 (may - august).

City Guided tour with visit to Bergen Maritime museum (3 hours)

Guided tour includes St. Mary's Church, Hanseatic seafront Bryggen, the residence of King Håkan, Rosenkrantz tower, open fish market and central square – Torgallmeningen. You will learn a lot about the history of the city and the Hanseatic League.

Maritime Museum: is situated near the St. Johans church and present history of seafaring in Norway. The exhibition includes ship models, paintings, and much more. Monday – Friday 10:00-16:00, Saturday - Sunday 11:00-16:00 (June - August).

Guided tours on cars/ buses

City guided tour and residence of the King (3 hours)

This city tour includes city center with the short stop at the viewing point, where you can see the King Håkan's castle and Bryggen. During the tour guide will tell you about the history of the city, Hanseatic League, Aquarium, National Theater, Edvard Grieg's concert hall. Leaving the town you will learn about the history of Norway, and make stops at the Kings's Residence Gamlehaugen and wooden church Fantorf. After the tour you will get back to the center of the city.

City guided tour and Trollhaugen – Edward Grieg's museum (3 hours)

This city tour includes city center with the short stop at the viewing point, where you can see the King Håkan's castle and Bryggen. During the tour guide will tell you about the history of the city, Hanseatic League, Aquarium, National Theater, Edvard Grieg's concert hall. Leaving the town you will learn about the history of Norway, and make stops at the Edvard Gieg's museum Trollhaugen, and visit wooden church Fantoft. After the tour you will get back to the center of the city.



City Guided tour with visit to Old Bergen Museum (3 hours)

This city tour includes city center with the short stop at the viewing point, where you can see the King Håkan's castle and Bryggen. During the tour guide will tell you about the history of the city, Hanseatic League, Aquarium, National Theater. Then you will go to the open air Old Bergen museum, where you will have the opportunity to visit old houses.

Old Bergen Museum: The museum consists of more than 40 18th -19th century houses. All together they represent a model of the town. Here you can find pharmacy, bakery, sailor's house, party house, school and much more. The museum is open daily 15.05.-31.08.

Combined guided tours car/bus + walking

Combined city guided tour (2 hours by car/ bus + 1 hour by foot)

This city tour includes city center with the short stop at the viewing point, where you can see King Håkan's castle and Bryggen. During the tour guide will tell you about the history of the city, the Hanseatic League, Aquarium, National Theater. Afterward you will leave the city and learn about the history of Norway, while you will be visiting King's Residence "Gamle Haugen" with the view over whole Bergen and you will also visit old wooden church Fantoft. Afterwards you will return to the city and continue with guided tour by car. You will visit Bryggen and learn about the Hanseatic League, then Santa Maria Church, King Håkan's castle and the Rosenkrantz Tower.

Out-of-town guided tours

Sognefjord in the nutshell – day trip from Bergen.

You will start your trip with train journey from Bergen to Myrdal, Where you will take famous Flåm railway to the charming Flåm village. This train road is unique and will grant you breathtaking views while taking you from the height of 860 meters above sea level down to the village. At Flåm you will have some time for lunch before continuing your trip by boat to Bergen. You can also choose to start this trip with the boat and finish with the train.

Hardanger in the nutshell – day trip from Bergen.

The train will you take from Bergen to Voss, where you will take a bus to Ulvik, and then by boat through amazing Hardangerfjord to small town of Eidfjord. Here you will have about 3 hours of free time, during which you can visit Hardangervida Nature Center and Voringsfossen waterfalls. Tickets can be bought at the boat you take from Ulvik to Eidfjord. After spending nice time at Eidfjord you will take a boat and set forth through Hardangerfjord to Norheimsund, than you will go back to Bergen by bus.

Trip to Folgefonna Glacier – whole day trip from Bergen

This breathtaking experience is suitable even for those who have never experienced ice climbing. The glacier is a thousand years old, of different shades of blue and turquoise and white, and constantly changing. The tour starts from the foot of the Glacier, where you can get by public transportation or ordering a transfer. There you will be met by a professional guide and instructor with all the special equipment, all you need is comfortable shoes and warm clothes.



Short Cruises from Bergen – 1-4 hours long.

Bergen fjord cruise – 1 hour

Osterfjord cruise to Mostraumen – 3-3,5 hours

On this trip, we take you to the innermost part of the Osterfjord, right into the narrow Mostraumen with its strong current. Boats are just able to pass through, which is an experience in itself. Our modern catamaran takes you on an adventure featuring several waterfalls and narrow fjords surrounded by steep mountains.

Osterfjord cruise by Vintage boat – 4 hours

Let us take you on a trip into the Osterfjord, just north of Bergen. White Lady is a vintage boat which has sailed up and down the fjords for more than 50 years. On this trip, you will experience the scenery of Western Norway at its best, with narrow fjord arms and majestic mountains!
