



Guided Tours by boats. Gothenburg.

OK Travel offers a variety of boat tours with the guide or audio guide in the second largest town in Sweden – Gothenburg. All tours are available during the summer.

Paddan Boat Tour, 1 hour

The tour will take you beneath many low bridges of the town, including the extremely low Osthyveln ("cheese slicer") bridge, which brings us out into the fascinating harbor with traditional shipyards, the fishing harbor, new and old housing, expanding commercial and academic sites and maritime museum.

Grand Archipelago Tour, 2,5 hours

The tour begins at Lilla Bommen in central Gothenburg and takes us passed the old fortress Nya Älvsborgs Fästning at high speed to the islands Saltholmen, Styrösö, Brännö, Kössö and several other picturesque islands in the southern archipelago.

We then continue across the bay to Hönö Klåva for a glimpse of the north side of the archipelago. We end the cruise with a 30 minute stop on the island Vinga.

Onboard a guide will tell you more about all the beautiful islands and houses we see along the way.

Boat Tour to Hisinge Island, 4 hours

On this tour of Sweden's fourth largest island you pass green meadows, barren cliffs, farmland with grazing cows, and much more.

During the course of the tour you will learn about the historical and legendary sites that you pass.

In the restaurant on board you will be invited to sample the exquisite à la carte menu while the M/S Carl Michael Bellman cruises steadily onward. Or why not enjoy the sunset out on the sundeck with a bite to eat from the café menu and perhaps something good to drink from the beer and wine list.

Archipelago Cruise to Marstrand, 6 hours

In the mini city of Marstrand, sailing is in focus. There are also many restaurants, shops and beautiful surroundings to enjoy. You go with the traditional M/S St. Erik built in 1881 that has wide experience in Gothenburg waters. On the way out, a snack buffet is offered, and on the way back from Marstrand, a genuine west-coast buffet is served.
