

Guided tours in other regions of Denmark.

Guided Tour to Roskilde (5 hours)

Roskilde is one of the oldest cities in Denmark, ancient capital of Danes. It is located on the high hill, where the magnificent view over the Roskilde fjord opens before the visitors eyes. This place is strongly associated with the Viking times and history. Right on the shore there is a museum of Vikingeskibsmuseet, where you can see five Viking ships, which was found at the bottom of the fjord. Other main attraction of Rodkilde is Cathedral, the tomb of Danish Monarchy.

Guided tour to Odense – home town of H. C. Andersen (8 hours)

House museum of H.C. Andersen is situated in the old town of Odense, in the historical part of town where visitors could see different craftsmen of old times. On one of the streets the tin soldier can be found, or the rose – a copy of the flower Kay gave to Gerda.

Trip to Legoland (3-4 hours in Legoland, total - 11 hours)

Near the town of Billund at the center of Jutland Island you can find Legoland – amazing park for kids and their parents. Everything in the park is made of Lego bricks. Here you can find models of the world-famous buildings, fantastic heroes and even animals and birds. Park occupies the territory of 100 000 sq. m. and consists of 45 million of original lego bricks.

Guided tour to Medieval Center of Denmark (10 hours)

In the small town dedicated to the medieval times you can witness knightly tournament, competitions in throwing of kernels, archery; you can try to wear the suit of armor, visit the old craft fair, and taste delicacies made by ancient recipes. There is also a playground with old time toys for the kids.

Guided tour "Land of Legents" (10 hours)

The Land of Legends is a place where 10 000 years of Danish history are coming to life. The area represents the collection of houses and households from the Stone Age, the Iron Age to the Viking Age. The unique natural beauty of this place with hills, forests, lakes and meadows allow you to feel connected to nature and the history. Here children can experience the atmosphere of ancient times and try to make fire, as the ancestors did in the Stone Age, chop wood with an ax, grind flour on a stone grinder and bake little biscuits. Both kids and adults can try archery, live in primitive huts and go sailing like real Vikings!

Trip to Safari-park (10 hours)

Safari-park is a zoo, where you can witness wild animals in their natural habitat, where they walk freely around you. At the park you will travel in special protected busses, and animals can be really close. The most impressive attraction is the meeting with tigers!



Guided tour to Dragsholm Castle

Dragsholm is the oldest castle on the territory of Denmark. This is a truly magnificent place with many centuries of history and beautiful landscape. Now it is a famous castle- hotel with ghosts. The atmosphere of the hotel is filled with the spirit of the Middle Ages and antiquity: carved furniture with satin upholstery, ancestral portraits on the walls and lots of trophies. It attracts a lot of tourists every year with the stories of ancient ghosts inhabiting its walls.

Gyuded tour "Castles of Fun Island" (10 hours)

Island of Fun is rightly called the garden of Denmark. The nature here is remarkable, with blooming gardens, green hills, castles and manors. We recommend to stay I one of the manor-hotels, to experience Denmark life of H. C. Andersen.

<u>Egeskov Castle</u>: In 30 km from Odense the most beautiful castle of Fun Island is located. It was built in 1544 from the red bricks on oak piles in the middle of the lake and considered to be one of the most well-preserved castles with the moat in Europe. A beautiful park with fountains and green labyrinths surrounds Egeskov Castle.

<u>Nyborg</u>: first capital of Denmark is old seaport town in the shore of Great Belt Strait. Nyborg is considered one of the most beautiful cities of Denmark, where medieval quarters with unique half-timbered houses were preserved. Here the first Danish Parliament Danehof sat in sessions.
