

# Guided Tours by boats. Stockholm.

# **Under the Bridges of Stockholm:**

During this tour you'll travel under fifteen bridges and pass through two locks connecting the Baltic Sea with Lake Mälaren. You will pass many of the city's sights as we slide by the different parts of Stockholm. Outside the window you will see the inner city, the Old Town, the islands Södermalm, Lilla and Stora Essingen, the new area Hammarby Sjöstad and the green areas of Djurgården. This boat tour is a perfect sightseeing trip when visiting Stockholm. Get a feel for the islands that make Stockholm such a beauty on water.

### **Archipelago tour:**

The tour takes 2,5 - 3 hours, just right to experience the best our beautiful archipelago has to offer. On board our guide will tell you all about the Stockholm archipelago, making the journey a beautiful and informative outing.

You will travel with either m/s Östanå I, built in 1906, or s/s Stockholm, built in 1931. Both are classic pearls and well-known elements in the archipelago. On board the cafeteria serve hot and cold drinks and sandwiches, salads and pies.

For departures at 10:30 and 13:30 (M/S Östanå I during spring/winter/summer), you can pre-book the chef's lunch special.

#### **Boat tour to ABBA The Museum:**

Enjoy listening to the story of ABBA, one of the most famous pop-bands in the world, from the waterfront. See the epic places where parts of ABBA The Movie were recorded and experience several of the places where the iconic pictures of ABBA were shot. And of course you get to hear many of the popular ABBA hits along the way.

The guiding onboard is in the same spirit and storytelling as at ABBA The Museum but in a sightseeing format. The manuscript has been written by Ingmarie Halling, curator at the museum and author of the new book "ABBA - The Backstage Stories".

The boat takes you around the beautiful and peaceful Djurgården and the tour finishes at ABBA The Museum at Djurgården where you can walk in the footsteps of ABBA and get that special ABBA feeling!

## **Historical Canal Tour:**

Join us on a sightseeing tour through the history of Stockholm. The tour starts at City Hall and takes you around the second largest island in the city, Kungsholmen. We also pass the historically interesting islands of Långholmen and Reimersholme.

Travelling through narrow canals, past leafy shorelines and many interesting buildings, you will learn all about the history of this beautiful city and its development from early industrial to modern times.
