09.05.2010: Social dialogue in Belgium

François Sant'Angelo, lawyer at the Centre for Equal Opportunities and Opposition to Racism gave a historical background of the social security in Belgium:

In 1944, after the second world war, an agreement called « Social pact » was signed between the employers and trade unions in order to recognize social rights

of the employees: health insurance, pension, unemployment indemnity but also to recognize that the companies were a factor of prosperity in a country. From the 50s on, this collaboration was not sufficient anymore and the state had to intervene in this dialogue. Nevertheless, this period is to be considered as one of important economical prosperity for Belgium as well as for the social well being of the workers class. This situation lasted until the 70s and these years were called the «Glorious 30s». The Belgian social model has been often held up as an example for the rest of Europe. But when the oil crisis stroke Europe between 1973 and 1979, the economical situation in Belgium became worse. Under the influence of a reconversion decided too late, inflation and structural unemployment appeared and has still its consequences today. This period, not yet ended at the beginning of the new century, is called « the seditious 30s ».

Nowadays, because of the big economical world crisis and the effects of globalization, Belgium and the European Union should change their policy. Bank employees and investors should be more severely controlled.

KURDISTAN OF TURKEY

AN ASSISTANT MAYOR ARRESTED

The 1^{estr} of May 2010, the assistant to the mayor of Şirnak in Kurdistan of Turkey, Abdulaziz Bilgi, has been arrested when leaving the prison of type E in Mardin and has been brought to the head quarter of security of this town. Bilgi was visiting his brother who's inprisoned there. The reason for his arrest is unknown. (avestakurd.net. 01.05.2010)

THE KURDISH DEPUTIES BOYCOTTED A LAW

The 03rd of May 2010, the Turkish parliament voted a change of article 8 concerning the banning of political parties, this within the project of change of the Turkish constitutional law dating from the military coup of 12.09.1980. The change's purpose making it more difficult to close political parties, has not been accepted by the majority of the parliamentarians: Instead of a minimum of 330 votes needed, only 327 voted in favor of the change. The two Turkish opposition parties, MHP (fascists) and CHP (nationalists) and certain deputies of the Islamic governing AKP voted against. The Kurdish deputies of the BDP, which replaces the recently banned DTP, didn't even enter in the benches and boycotted in this way the change.

Many Kurds, including party members criticized this attitude. Most Turkish intellectuals who support the Kurdish issue were very surprised. The former parliamentary group leader of the Kurdish DTP and former chairman of the party, Ahmet Türk, stated to the Turkish magazine Aksiyon that the attitude of his party members disappointed him and that the fact of voting the same as members of the MHP and CHP is harmful for him. Osman Özçelik, deputy from Siirt for the BDP and Ufuk Uras, deputy from Istanbul complained because of the attitude of their party.

Because of these critics, the BDP has organized a meeting and stated that it concerns «a red line». PKK-leader Abdullah Öcalan from his side, criticized the attitude of the opponents of the BDP and called on them to protest against the Turkish governing party AKP! BOMBING OF IRAQI KURDISTAN

The 10th of May 2010, Turkish artillery forces bombed the border region of Şêladizê in the province of Duhok in Iraqi Kurdistan. One building fell in and its owner,

Rêkan Huseyn, was killed. His wife and three children have been seriously injured.

JOURNALIST CONDEMNED TO 166 YEARS AND SIX MONTHS IN PRISON!

The 13th of May 2010, a Turkish court of Diyabekir in Kurdistan of Turkey condemned the former editor of the Kurdish daily Azadiya Welat, Vedat Kurşun, to 166 years and 6 months imprisonment because of « propaganda for a terroristic organization »!

Kurşun, in prison since February 2008, is accused of having published at 103 different occasions news, events and photos concerning the PKK. His lawyers stated that they will appeal.

Reporters Without Borders condemned strongly this decision and called on the European Union to do the same.

The Kurdish government protested sharply against these repeated attacks.

The 14th of May 2010, a police action has been organized in 11 Turkish towns, including Istanbul, Ankara and Konya, in which 30 persons have been arrested, related to the Ergenekon trial.

Ergenekon is an obscure organization, responsible for numerous non elucidated murders (see previous newsletters).

The 17th of May 2010, the 5th Heavy Penal Court of Diyarbekir condemned the chairman of the Siirt section of the unofficial BDP, Sıdık Taş, to seven years and one month imprisonment for « propaganda for an organization ».

The 09th of October 2009, Sıdık Taş had organized an activity in occasion of the 10th imprisonment anniversary of PKK-leader Abdullah Öcalan.

The 19th of May 2010, Turkish minister of Internal Affairs Beşir Atalay welcomed co-chairman of the Kurdish BDP Selahattin Demirtaş and vice-chairwoman of this group in parliament, Mrs Ayla Akat Ata. Demirtaş expressed to him her doubts about the process of « Kurdish opening ». The minister answered him that it is not finished and will be continued. He added that the dialogue between the two sides was not sufficient and that he will reinforce it.

A KURDISH ORGANISATION DISSOLVED

Le 26 May 2010, the Court of First Instance of Diyarbekir decided to dissolve Goç Der, an organization for help to refugees. It is accused of conducting separatist activities. The13th of March 2006, the police had entered its offices, confiscated campaign pamphlets entitled «I consider Mister Öcalan as my political will» and put its leaders into custody. The chairman of this organization, Huseyin Daş, has been imprisoned and the other leaders liberated. When the trial had been rejected by the 1^{est} Court of Diyarbekir, the general prosecutor appealed to the High Court. The latter had decided to dissolve Diyar Koç Der and the court of Diyarbekir executed the order. (netkurd.com, 27.05.2010)

AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL REPORT

In May 2010, Amnesty International published its report of 2010 concerning the situation of human rights in the world.

Concerning Turkey, the report mentions that there is little progress in the field of protection of human rights but Turkey is accused of not controlling the increasing abuse in different other fields. The trials are long and unfair. Suspects and children face criminal charges based on the anti-terrorism law ... People who express their opinion in a non violent way, especially in criticizing the situation of the Kurds and the Armenians, are punished because the police starts an investigation and charges against them. Among them, authors, journalists, political activists and human rights associations ...

200 PEOPLE ARRESTED

The 28th of May 2010, 200 people were arrested after a vast operation against the KCK (Association of the Kurdish Society) started in April 2009 in different Kurdish and Turkish towns. After a trial, 44 persons were found guilty and imprisoned. Among them leaders of the unofficial Kurdish BDP, students and human rights defenders. They are accused of membership of an organization and support to terrorist acts.

METAL WALL AT SYRIAN BORDER

The Turkish authorities are building a metal wall of 4 meters height along the Syrian border separating the district of Nusaybin belonging to Mardin from the city of Kamichli (Qamişlî), in Kurdistan of Syria. Their excuse being mines found in this area, which could be dangerous for playing children.

The 28th of May 2010, the city council of Nusaybin compared this wall to the «Wall of Berlin» and asked

the leader of this area to remove the mines instead of building a wall.

KURDISTAN OF IRAQ

CHIEF OF ARMY SADDAM HUSEYN IN SWEDEN

The 04th of May 2010, a delegation of the Kurdish organization Kurdocide Watch-CHAK went to the head quarter of the Swedish police to contest the decision to grant asylum to the chief of the army of Saddam Husseyn Muhammed Kemal Abed, taken by the Swedish government on 20.11.2009.

The delegation was composed of the vice-chairman of CHAK, Gabar Çiyan, the chairman of the Swedish section of CHAK, Kader Nadir and journalist Şîlan Saîdî. She showed the Swedish police documents proving that Muhammed Kemal Abed had a capital role in the manufacturing, testing and use of chemical and nuclear weapons in Iraq. He had used these arms against the Kurdish people in the Anfall-campaign (the loot) between 1987 and 1989.

ATTACKS IN THE ARABISED REGIONS OF KURDISTAN

Two of the guardians and one civilian have been injured.

TURKISH-KURDISH FRIENDSHIP ASSOCIATION

The 20th of May 2010, a three day' meeting has begun at the International Hotel of Erbil in Iraqi Kurdistan in order to create the Turkish-Kurdish Friendship Association.

The first day, the meeting was organized in the presence of Governor Newzad Hadî of Erbil and the former Minister of Culture Felekeddîn Kakeyî, who have both taken the floor. Afterwards, an artistic group presented a program of Sufi music symbolizing the human feelings founded on equality, peace, dialogue and interior peace. Next on the program was a group from Kurdistan of Iran presenting Kurdish dances.

The next day, Turkish and Kurdish intellectuals such as authors, researchers an academicians discussed the creation of an open dialogue between both sides. The same day, the participants also visited President Mesûd Berzanî.

The preparations for this association have begun since New Year. Its founders decided to edit a magazine in two languages treating social, political and cultural subjects in Turkey and Iraqi Kurdistan. KURDISH LEADERS IN MOSKOW

The 21st of May 2010, the 4th Conference of Patriotic Parties has been convened by the chairman of the Russian Liberal Democratic Party, Vladimir Jirinovsky. The Kurdish delegation of the PDK (Democratic Party of Kurdistan) was composed by the secretary of the political bureau, Fazil Mîranî and by the representative of the Kurdish government of Iraq to Russia, Dr. Xoşevî Mella Ibrahîm.

At the end of the conference, Mr. Jirinosvky said that it is has been over 100 years that the United States and Europe haven't managed to solve the problem of 40 million of Kurds while they managed to create the state of Kosovo in ex-Yugoslavia and even recognized it. He added that the neglecting of the Kurdish issue is a disgrace for the world.

Then, Mr. Mîranî explained in a general way the political situation and state of security in the region of Kurdistan of Iraq and the last parliamentary elections in Iraq. He gave also an overview of the last 18 years of democratic experience in Kurdistan and said that thanks to this democracy, progress in the social, political, economic and cultural field has been booked and more than 20 countries, including Russia, opened consulates in Kurdistan. Two international airports make access for travelers easier.

The first focusing on an Arabic audience in order to explain the events in Kurdistan and the second targeting the Kurds living outside Kurdistan, especially in Baghdad.

5 PERSONS HANGED



On 09 May 2010, 5 persons, from which 4 Kurds of the PJAK (Iranian wing of the PKK) and a woman were hanged in the sinister prison of Evin in Teheran. Their names are Ferzad Kemanger, Alî Heyderiyan, Ferhad Vekîlî, Şîrîn Elem Holî and Mehdî Eslamiyan.

According to the English daily The Guardian, the Iranian army announced the state of urgency in Kurdistan after protests at the university of Teheran and in Kurdish towns as Pîranşar, Sine, Mahabad, Kamyaran, Maku and Urmiye.

Their families told that they were threatened and that they didn't have the right to follow the case during the coming 2 weeks.

A 15 year old Kurd called Enîs Şêx Ahmedî has been arrested by the secret services of Sanandaj during demonstrations on 13 May and disappeared since then. Witnesses declared that he was manhandled publicly when arrested.

THE DAUGHTER OF A KURDISH POLITICIAN DEPRIVED OF HER RIGHTS

They also told her she cannot work for public services after her studies because of the activities of her father and that her father could "disappear".

DIFFICULTIES TO OBTAIN IDENTITY PAPERS

According to the internet site www.kurdwatch.org, persons living outside Syria cannot obtain identity papers anymore without the permission of the Syrian secret services. According to this site, the direction of the national secret services sent a list of persons living abroad to the municipalities' registry offices and ordered them not to register these people nor their fami-

lies without their permission. Most of the persons appearing on the list are Kurdish. There are also some Arabic and Christian names.

The site managed to obtain the names of 30 persons originated from the city of Tirbêsipî in Kurdistan of Syria.

INTERNATIONAL POETRY FESTIVAL IN ISTANBUL

Guests had come from Sweden, Denmark, Finland, Russia, Romania, Bulgaria, Palestine, Greece, Chechnya, the three parts of Kurdistan and Armenia.

Kurdish poets not only participated in this festival but contributed also to cultural activities organized by several Turkish universities and schools such as Boğazcı, Kasımpaşa and Şişli Terakki where they performed Kurdish songs and poems. They also participated in this kind of activities at the centers of Sesam (centre of film artists), YKK (centre of the Yapı Kredi bank), Centre for Engineers and at the TMMOB (Association of Industrials) at Galatasary, at the Foundation of the famous poet Nazim Hikmet and at the Kurdish theatre Seyrî Mesel.

CONFERENCE ON KURDISH LITERATURE IN KURDISTAN OF IRAN

The 05th and the 06th of May2010, the university of Kurdistan in Sine (Sanandaj) in Kurdistan of Iran, organized a conference on Kurdish literature. All universities where literature is taught were invited. 41 experts took the floor.
