Parade 2026 – Business & Group Registration Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

These Terms and Conditions apply to all businesses, organisations, charities, and community groups (“Participants”) registering to take part in the Pride in Hull 2026 Parade (“the Event”). By submitting a registration, you agree to comply with these terms.

2. Eligibility

- This registration is strictly for **businesses and organised groups only**.
 - Individual participants must register via the designated ticketing system.
 - All Participants must support and uphold the inclusive values of Pride and the LGBTQ+ community.
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3. Registration & Acceptance

- Submission of this form does **not guarantee participation**.
 - All registrations are subject to approval by the organisers.
 - Organisers reserve the right to refuse or withdraw participation at their discretion.
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4. Parade Format (Pedestrianised Event)

- The parade is **fully pedestrianised — no vehicles, floats, or motorised transport are permitted**.
 - All Participants must take part on foot.
 - Any props or items brought must be **handheld or safely carried** and manageable within a walking procession.
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5. Conduct & Representation

- Participants must act respectfully, inclusively, and in line with Pride values.
- Any form of discrimination, harassment, or offensive behaviour will result in removal.

- Messaging, branding, and displays must not be offensive, discriminatory, or harmful.
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6. Parade Participation Requirements

- Participants must provide accurate information about their group and planned participation.
 - Groups must remain together and follow steward instructions at all times.
 - Final placement within the parade is determined solely by organisers.
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7. Health & Safety

- Participants are responsible for the safety and wellbeing of their group.
 - A **risk assessment** may be required upon request.
 - Groups must not bring any items that could pose a hazard to others.
 - All instructions from stewards, security, and emergency services must be followed at all times.
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8. Prohibited Items

The following are not permitted:

- Vehicles or motorised equipment
 - Large or unstable structures
 - Pyrotechnics, flares, or fireworks
 - Illegal substances
 - Any item deemed unsafe by organisers
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9. Alcohol & Substance Use

- Participants must behave responsibly.
 - Anyone under the influence to the extent they pose a risk may be removed from the Event.
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10. Arrival & Participation

- Participants must arrive at the designated assembly point at their allocated time.
 - Late arrivals may not be permitted to join.
 - Participants are expected to complete the parade route unless otherwise instructed.
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11. Media & Photography

- The Event will be photographed and filmed.
 - By participating, you consent to the use of images and footage for promotional purposes by Pride in Hull and its partners.
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12. Branding & Representation

- Participation does not imply official sponsorship unless agreed in writing.
 - All branding must be appropriate and in keeping with the values of the Event.
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13. Cancellations & Changes

- Organisers reserve the right to amend, postpone, or cancel the Event if necessary.
 - No liability will be accepted for costs incurred by Participants.
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14. Liability

- Participation is at your own risk.
 - Pride in Hull is not liable for loss, injury, or damage unless caused by negligence.
 - Participants are responsible for their own property.
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15. Data Protection

- Information provided will be used solely for the administration of the Event and handled in accordance with data protection legislation.
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16. Agreement

By submitting the registration form, you confirm that:

- You are authorised to act on behalf of the organisation/group.
- You have read and agree to these Terms and Conditions.
- You will ensure all members of your group comply with them.
