The Viterbo Branch of the Italian Mozart Association announces a Special Edition (No. IX) of the International Opera Singing Competition "Salice d'Oro". The Competition will take place in the city of Novara at the Fondazione Teatro Coccia (Coccia Theatre Foundation) from the 30<sup>st</sup> of August to the 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2019.

## The Goals

The competition provides the young artists with an opportunity to meet the insiders including important theatre managers and agencies, so as to facilitate the process of entering or improuving their employment positions. Apart from money prises, the jury members have an inalienable personal right to reward the artists they deem eligible for being accepted into the jurors' respective professional working environments, regardless of the outcome of the official selection.

- Casa Musicale Sonzogno Prize: A score of Casa Musicale Sonzogno will be offered to the three winners
- Milan Rotary Club Prize: a concert; the date and procedure to be established.

# **Elegibility Requirements**

Are admitted singers of all nationality born after the First January 1984 (age 18 years or over).

### How to apply

All the candidates must send the request of their partecipation before the 27th of August 2019 by email with the following documents:

- A short CV (either in Italian or in English);

## Programme

All the candidates must present four operatic arias in the original language, performed by heart bringing also the piano score

The Viterbo Branch of the Italian Mozart Association provides all candidates with piano accompanist. However, should they so desire, they are free to bring their own pianist at their own expense.

The competition structure is as follows:

- Qualifiers: Friday 30<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2019, two mornings and two afternoons at the Teatro Coccia of Novara. Every candidate will perform an air of her/his choice, with piano accompaniment. the Jury reserves right to ask to perform the second aria indicated in the competitor's program.
- Finals: Sunday the 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2019 at 3 p.m. at the Teatro Coccia of Novara. Every candidate will perform an air chosen by the Jury from the four airs indicated in the submitted programme. The test will be attended by the public. The finals will be concluded with the voting and the award ceremony.
- The dates and timetables above are subject to change, pending the number of the competitors to be evaluated.
- In the case of *ex-aequo*, the price will be shared by the winners.
- The members of the Jury cannot vote for a candidate which is either a relative or linked with him professionaly.
- The Committee reserves the right to interrupt a performance and/or to request a repetition. Apart from the above-mentioned eventuality, no juror may abstain from voting.
- The Jury Committee judgement is unappealable.

### **Final Provisions**

- The candidates authorise and waive any remuneration for all possible recordings or broadcasts by either public or private radio and television.
- All room and board costs are at the participants own expense.
- The organisers decline responsibility for any risks or damages of any nature that may befall the participants during and/or derive from the competition activities.
- The Jury reserves the right to make decisions concerning anything not determined by the regulations.
