The meeting is hosted this time by TPAC – the ThermoPlastic composite Application Centre – in Enschede, which recently celebrated its 10th birthday! TPAC focuses on cost-effective processing, automation and recycling of Thermoplastic Composites. We start with a lecture program under the theme "Thermoplastic composites for everyday applications" followed by a visit program. Being directly connected to Saxion University of Applied Sciences, TPAC is furthermore actively involved in education and thereby provides the market with young professionals with state of the art knowhow on thermoplastic composites.

The venue is easily accessible by public transport and by car:

- Parking your car is possible at Q-Park Enschede, Zuidmolenstraat 1, Enschede. From there it's a short walk to TPAC.
- For public transport: TPAC is at a 5 minutes' walk from Enschede train station. If you wish to stay overnight nearby, we recommend IntercityHotel Enschede, Willem Wilminkplein 5, Enschede: next to the train station and city centre, short walk from TPAC. An alternative would be the Van der Valk Hotel Enschede, easily accessible by car, next to the highway exit and relatively close to TPAC/Enschede city centre (by car)
