COMMUNITY FAMILY SUPPORT PACKAGE

Support and guidance for families as they return for a residential assessment.

Support

- ◆ Developmental stages
- ◆ Cooking
- ◆ Budgeting and accessing benefits
- ◆ Introduction to local community resources
- ◆ Routine setting
- ◆ Child Protection



COMMUNITY ASSESSMENTS

A 6-week assessment conducted in the home over 3 to 4 days a week.

All of the community based assessments are led by experienced child protection social workers (with the support of family support workers) who are responsible for assessing, managing and monitoring the family from beginning to the end any intervention.

Assessment

- ♦ Parenting sessions to include Triple P & PAMS tools
- ♦ Child Protection
- ♦ Healthy relationship
- ♦ Freedom Programme
- ♦ Self esteem
- ♦ Budgeting
- ♦ Cooking
- ♦ Behavior Management
- ♦ Health and Safety/ Personal Hygiene

PAMs assessments on request

Each assessment will include a written report on the families progression and any recommendations.

DAY ASSESSMENTS

Conducted over a 2-12 weeks timeframe.

Parent(s) and child(ren) attending Savannah Contact Centre/Residential Centre.

Assessment

The assessment is used as a tool to assess a parent's commitment to undertaking an assessment or rehabilitation back into the community following a residential assessment.

Tailored sessions to meet the family's needs.



PARENTING AND CRISIS SUPPORT

- ♦ **Crisis and behavior management support for parent(s) in their home.**

Support

Empowering parents to develop their confidence in applying positive behavior management strategies. Parents are supported in learning positive parenting skills to enhance a child's learning and development to include:

- ♦ Establishing a night time routine
- ♦ Healthy eating
- ♦ Communication

The service is solution-focused, with time limited interventions of up to 12 weeks.

Staff embrace a personalized approach when supporting parent(s) and child(ren) in recognizing specific challenging, harmful, risky behaviors impacting on their family.

YOUNG PARENTS OUTREACH

Intervention from 12-26 weeks/depending on the family needs.

Working in partnership with Local Authorities to support families with looked after children or children in pre-care proceedings in their transition back to the family home.

Supporting care leavers, parents aged 24 and under .

Support

- ♦ Health in pregnancy, Sexual health and contraception
- ♦ Child Development
- ♦ Housing and Homelessness
- ♦ Domestic violence, Co-parenting and healthy relationships
- ♦ Employment, training and benefits
- ♦ Role modelling
- ♦ Young fathers sessions
- ♦ Reunification Package

Regular meetings, sessions and 1:1 support sessions in the home or at our center.
