10 am – 4 pm. Sunday. Mr. Berger and Ann the Jester will create magic, mingle and teach kids how to perform tricks and practice witchcraft.

10 am Saturday and 1:30 pm Sunday. Guidance of the Church of Marstrand. Christina Svensson will tell us about the fascinating history of the church.

10:30 am – 6 pm Saturday and Sunday. The Carlsten Fortress. Admit two but pay for only one individual if you come dressed in Victorian clothes. Guided tours Saturday and Sunday at 12:00 noon, 2 pm, 3 pm and 4 pm.

11 am and 2 pm on Friday and at 10 am on Saturday. Theatrical group Happy Clown plays theater for the kids in the playground in front of the Marstrand Church.

11 am – 12:00 noon. Saturday-Sunday. Storyteller Mikael Thomasson tells fairytales for children at Köpmansgården with an entrance from Paradise Park.

11 am and 2 pm. Saturday. Kulturskolan Summer Camp. The end of the school term is celebrated with a Musical Camp featuring a circus theme in Paradise Park.

12:00 noon, 13.30 pm and 4 pm. Saturday. Brass sextet of the Hussar Regiment in Paradise Park entertains us with music from the Victorian era.

12:00 noon – 3 pm. Saturday and Sunday. Lunch of Soup with home baked bread, coffee and small pancakes with jam and cream. Come to Sinnenas Trädgård ("Garden of the Five Senses") in the Parish Hall of the Marstrand Church located at Hospitalsgatan.

12:15 on Saturday. Fashion Show in the company of the Kungälv Orchestra, the Pom Pom Girls and Shire Horses. We gather in Paradise Park and jointly walk to meet King Oscar II when he arrives on S/S Bohuslän which only arrives on the Saturday of the Festival.

12:30 Saturday. Kungälv Orchestra, Pom Pom Girls and Happy Clown entertain us and we engage in singalong to await the arrival of King Oscar II.

Around 13:15 Saturday. Fortress Governor Eiwe Svanberg welcomes King Oscar II to Marstrand with a welcoming presentation that is identical to the speech held when the King arrived at Marstrand during his lifetime. King Oscar cuts the ribbon to inaugurate Victorian Days of 2023.

13:15 Sunday. Public Baths Director greets Oscar II welcome to Marstrand. Please note: King Oscar II arrives at the Royal Steps at Paradise Park on Saturday but on Sunday, he takes the harbor ferry to Marstrand.

2 pm – 3 pm Saturday. Singalong with the Ukulele Orchestra Styrbords Halsar on the wharf between Bergs Konditori and Arnell på Kajen.

2 pm – 3 pm. Saturday-Sunday. "Villa Svea," an exciting lecture on the Swedish emigrants and their colony Villa Svea in Argentina. Mats Erasmie. Kristallsalen, Marstrand City Hall, free of charge.

14:15 – 3 pm. Saturday-Sunday. The Royal Dip. All those who dare to take a dip in the ocean gather in their traditional bathing suits typical of the by-gone era. All are welcome and we have at least 10 classical bathing suits from the turn of the century to loan those who wish to give it a try. After a much-acclaimed warm-up, we jump, walk or dive into the ocean together. Afterwards, we invite daredevils to heated Swedish arrack punch. Please join us at Kalkeberget, the rocks near Strandverket.

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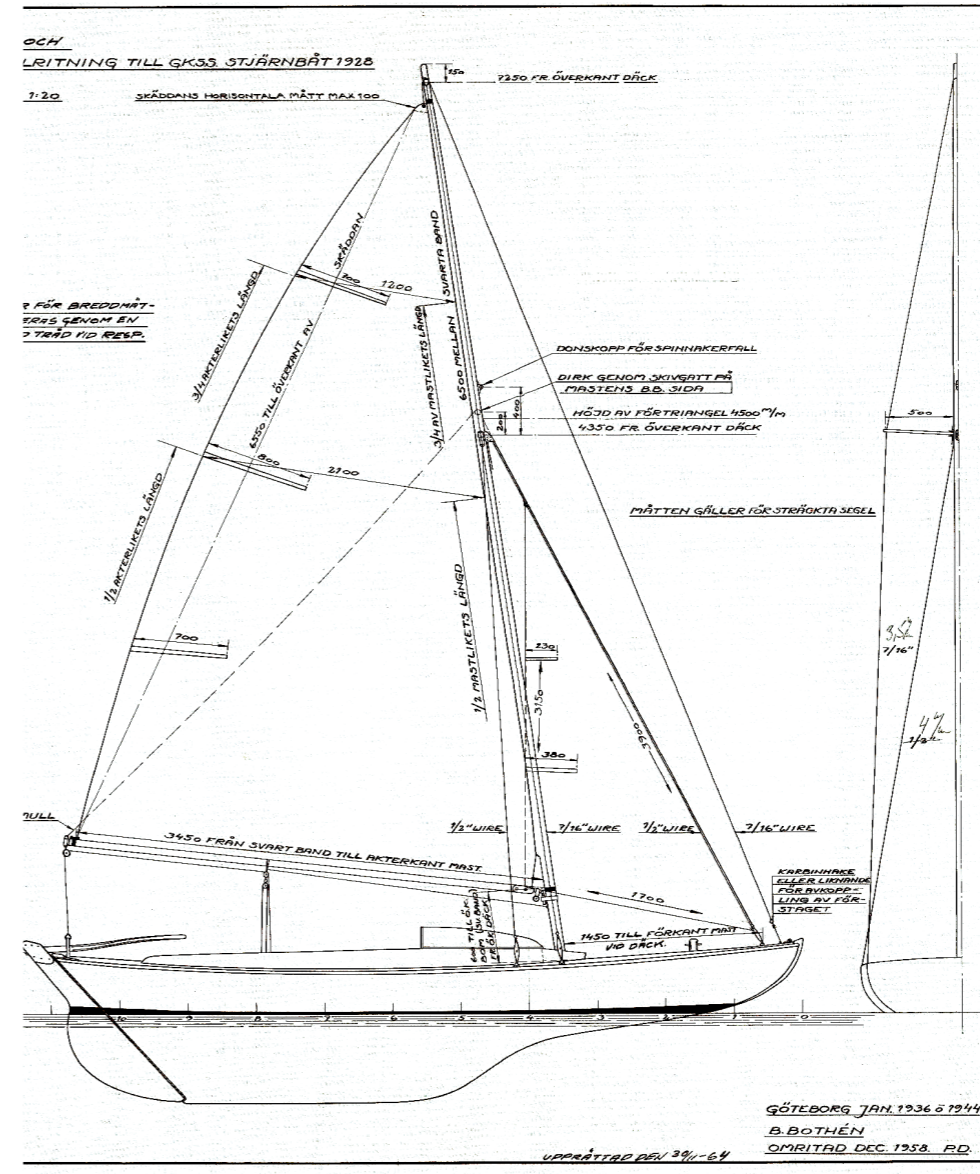

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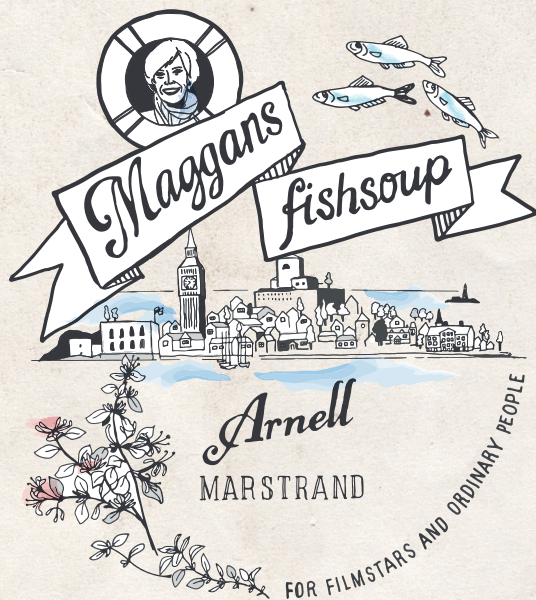
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
