

The Garment of Righteousness

## Wearing the Garment of Righteousness

Personal repentance of sin, receives Jesus as Lord and Saviour, sins washed away by the Blood of Jesus, receives the Holy Spirit, born-again and restored. Then you receive your spotless garment of fine linen bright and clean. Walks on the Highway of Righteousness and Holiness. Jesus writes your name in the Book of Life (Citizenship Book of Heaven)

## Christlike

Holy Spirit guided and faithful believer. Receives continuous teaching on the Word of God (Bible) from the Holy Spirit until full maturity reached (Christlikeness, Image of God). "Be holy as I Am holy. Without holiness no one will see the Lord". Holy means separation from sin by obedience to God's Word.









### **Maintaining the Garment**

Continuous repentance of sin and obedience to God's Word cleanses any spots and stains of sin that may hit your garment. Continue stable walk on the Highway of Righteousness and Holiness. Do not stray offroad. Receive continuous teaching from the Holy Spirit.

## Ready for the Wedding Feast

Mature Fruits of the Spirit (Christlike), Rapture ready, faithful to Jesus and wearing the wedding garment of fine linen, bright and clean.

Jesus is acquainted with the mature believer and opens the door to the Wedding Feast of the Lamb in Heaven.

# The Disobedient Believer





#### Wearing the Garment of Righteousness

Personal repentance of sin, receives Jesus as Lord and Saviour, sins washed away by the Blood of Jesus, even receives the Holy Spirit, born-again and restored. Then you receive your spotless garment of fine linen bright and clean. Starts walking on the Highway of Righteousness and Holiness. Jesus writes your name in the Book of Life (Citizenship Book of Heaven)

#### **Immature Believer**

Receives continuous spiritual teaching from the world marketplace or church in apostasy and not on the Word of God (Bible) from the Holy Spirit. Listening to false prophets teachers, familiar spirits. Not maturing to Christlikeness and bears no Fruit of the Spirit. Serving the Lord his own way not His way. Not listening to the warnings of the Holy Spirit. Straying and walking offroad or a parallel road Into Apostasy.



Careless Christianity: complacent, backsliding, unfaithful and/or worldly. Garment is hit with spots and stains of sin. Double-minded and straying from the Highway of Holiness and Righteousness (parallel road). Walking with one foot in the world and the other towards the Lord. No repentance of sin therefore garment not cleansed by the Blood of Jesus. Sees no need to repent of sin, turn away from sin, or change direction as he believes he is already saved (Abuse of the Grace). Does not listen to the Holy Spirit for teaching to reach maturity (Not Christlike).

### Not ready for the Wedding Feast

No Fruit of the Spirit (Not Christlike). Not Rapture ready, unfaithful to Jesus and wearing dirty wedding garment.

Jesus not acquainted with immature believer, "I don't know you". Rejected at the entrance to the Wedding Feast of the Lamb. Remains on earth gnashing teeth. Enters 7 year Tribulation Period.

Requirement to enter Heaven after Rapture: do not take the Mark of the Beast and be ready to die for your faith in Jesus (Martyrdom).

Taking the Mark of the Beast: means worshipping Satan and not repenting from sin. Name deleted from the Book of Life and salvation lost. Thrown into the Lake of Fire which is the Second Death.

# Wearing the Garment of Satan

Non-Believer, atheist, agnostic or idolater walking in sin. Sins not washed away by the Blood of Jesus. Following demon spirits from the fallen spiritual world and influenced by them. Walking in the world. No trust, no faith in Christ. Wearing fine linen scarlet and purple (Satans Garment).



Fine linen scarlet and purple. Living carelessly and complacent. Disconnected from God. Continuously deceived, walking with both feet in the world and sees no need to change direction. Continuously rejecting the free gift of Salvation by rejecting Jesus, the Cross and the Blood. Continuously disconnected from God with no repentance of sin. Continuously wearing the flithy garment of Satan. Continuously rejecting the Holy Spirit. Continuously listening to the fallen spirits in the occultic world and following them. Enjoying the fruits of sin.



No Fruit of the Spirit. No wedding garment and pays the price of sin himself. Reaps the fruit of sin for himself. Welcomed into the Antichrist kingdom of 7 years. Takes the Mark of the Beast. Worships Satan.

Enters eternal damnation and separation from God. Thrown into the Lake of Fire (Second Death) burning with brimstone (Lava). Squandered life. Missed opportunity for blotting out sin. Repenting with no hope. The Blood of Jesus not available. Paradise lost.

Born-again: the receiving of God's Holy Spirit into our spirit for teaching and guidance into God's Word (Bible) in order to grow up to a fully matured Christian (Christ likeness, image of God, John 20:22, John 3:1-8, John 14:26)

God does not want anyone to spend eternity in Hell with Satan and his fallen angels (The Occult World). Before soul separates from body and eternity fixed and permanent, what free-to-choose, one-time-offer is present as your <u>only</u> way back to God? Rom. 3:25, Eze 18:32

Disobedient believer: Matt 7:21-23, Luke 6:46, Hebrews 10:26

Salvation of the soul: to become one with the Lord and all His Word (Eph. 4:13) by being faithful, obedient and complying with the Lord and His Word (Acts 16:30-31, 1 Peter 1:9, Daniel 9:4, Proverbs 4:4, Phil. 2:12)

Abuse of the Grace: people who continue to live in sin after being born-again and receiving the Holy Spirit. The gifts of the Holy Spirit remain active but they are not followers of God's Word (not Christ like) and the soul is not transformed to maturity (Ephesians 4:13) and bears no Fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23). Jesus calls them lawless (Matthew 7:21-23, 25:12, Hebrews 6:4-6, Romans 8:13, 12:2, 1 John 2:17). An example is Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve disciples of Jesus. He also had the gifts of the Spirit (Matthew 10:1) nevertheless his soul did not transform and mature to become like Jesus (2 Corinthians 3:18, Philippians 2:12, Eph 4:13). He remained worldly (John 15:4), covetous (John 12:6), did not turn away from sin, and produced no fruits of the Spirit (John 12:6, Matthew 3:8). In the end, he was lost (Matthew 7:19, Luke 13:9, John 15:2, Acts 1:25, Hebrews 6:4-6).

"I never knew you": people who operated in the gifts of the Spirit. However, God was not allowed to transform their thoughts, their soul, to grow up and be Christ-like (Eph. 4:13). They did not receive in obedience the rebuke and teaching given by the Holy Spirit for the soul to become one with the Lord and all His Word and therefore remained an infant (Eph. 4:14). Jesus calls them evildoers! (Mt 7:22-23, 10:1-4, 25:1-13).
