CONDITIONS

- Open to any young handler using any registered JSS Members' Jacob sheep
- Entries limited to 100 on a first come basis
- Winners will be kindly asked to submit a photograph of themselves and sheep with their rosette. Permission will be sought to use photographs for publicity by the JSS.
- Young Handlers will be judged by Nation, then the Winners from each class in each Country of the 4 Nations (England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales) will be put forward into an overall Championship. Overseas entries are historically Southern Region so will be included in England.
- All adult sheep must be registered with the Jacob Sheep Society

- **FOR ALL CLASSES: Three photographs** will be required of the Young Handler showing them at any stage of preparing the sheep they intend to show.
- **FOR ALL CLASSES: One short video** will be required of the Young Handler showing the sheep (on or off the halter) to include standing the sheep up
Maximum time of entire video 4 minutes, no minimum time set.
Each age group has to include a talk about the sheep they are showing in their video;
- **FOR CLASS 1 (Under 8years)**: talk about the sheep (such as age/gender/any other information they wish to add such as sheeps' name/ how it was prepared etc.)
- **FOR CLASS 2 (8 – 12 years)**: talk about the sheep - **including** why they have chosen that one (good mouth/ conformation/ to breed standards) and how they have prepared it
- **FOR CLASS 3 (13 to 18 years)**: talk about the sheep - **including** why they have chosen that one (good mouth/ conformation/ to breed standards) and how they have prepared it **plus** describe day to day shepherding – have they been involved in worming/ foot trimming/ vaccinating – what products do they/ the owners use in the flock – how do they/ the owner market their sheep/ products (wool/ meat etc.)

- If your entry is accepted, you will receive details on how to submit your entry online.
- The judge's decision is final
