## **Jacob Sheep Society**

Anyone attending a sale or other event held by or on behalf of the Jacob Sheep Society shall indemnify the Society from and against all actions, suits, expenses and claims on account of or in respect of any such damage or injury which may be so caused.

### **We would like to draw your attention to the following:**

Rejected Sheep will not be sold at any time at Official Shows & Sales

Please note that **substituted** sheep will have white tape on their horn, **rejected** sheep will have red tape, and those sheep that pass the inspection but **need an announcement** from the auctioneer at the time of sale, e.g. an older sheep that is slightly sharp on its mouth, will have blue tape on their horn.

The **Tay-Sachs status** of all entered sheep must be declared on the entry form and in the catalogue, i.e. tested clear, bred clear, carrier or untested.

### **Rules relating to this Show & Sale in particular:**

A vendor may only *show* 2 sheep in each class, but any number can be entered for sale.

Although the byelaws state that sheep must be registered by 21 days before the date of the sale, the catalogue for this sale is produced directly from the Grassroots database and it is imperative that registrations are lodged with Grassroots either electronically or on paper (marked as including sheep for the sale) by the closing date of 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

Pedigree certificates of any sheep already registered must be attached to the sale entry form.

## **McCartneys**

1. Vendors may deliver Sheep on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> August from 2.00-5.00pm and Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> August from 6.00-8.30am.
2. Entry Fees £7.20 per Sheep, to include straw. Entry fees are collected to subsidise the printing of the sale catalogue – once catalogue is printed the entry fee is forfeited if the animal is then withdrawn.  
All sheep will be sold in Guineas (£1.05), and in catalogue order.  
The auctioneers to charge a commission of 5%.  
In line with recent years the JSS will waive its right to a levy at this sale.
3. Cleansing facilities for vehicles and trailers will be available on site for a nominal charge.
4. It is the vendor's and purchaser's responsibility to ensure that all DEFRA rules and regulations are adhered to, with regard to movement of sheep at the time.
5. Food will be available all day on Tuesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> August in the canteen.
6. Vendors should ensure that their sheep are identified with the auctioneer's lot number tags as soon as possible to aid both the inspectors and potential purchasers.
7. ALL SHEEP SOLD, MUST BE SOLD IN THE SALE RING OR THROUGH THE AUCTIONEER'S OFFICE

***The catalogue will be produced directly from the Grassroots Database. If your sheep is not registered before the deadline it cannot be accepted in the sale.***
