Welcome to Round Sealand/Sjælland Rundt Sailing Week 2022

Elsinore Yacht Club welcomes you and your crew to this year's race starting on June 16th.

This year the regatta will be sailed with a classic start. The starting times will be sorted in the traditional way.

We continue to provide an opportunity to try out the extremes by racing single handed or two handed. A tough race, but this is what people ask for, so you should also be able to test it during Round Seeland.

Sailors who do not have racing as their primary sail sport, should also get the opportunity to participate. We therefore have a cruising class, which is preferably for without boat certificates. They get the opportunity to experience Round Seeland without having to familiarize themselves with the Racing Rules of Sailing. Cruising sailors sail under the International Rules for Preventing Collisions at Sea round the clock, both related to the racing participants and to others. The race participants will be sailing under the Racing Rules of Sailing part 2, including the Racing rules 2021-2024 from the Danish Sailing Association. For the single class type boats, the regulation of the class applies. Singlehanded and Twohanded classes will be sailing as cruising as well due to the fact that manoeuvring abilities are limited caused by the limited crew.

This year we have also introduced a race with stop on Vejrø. Participants will get a gastronomic experience I company with other sailors. We introduce a social event for the sailors to enjoy the beautiful island Vejrø.

Finally, some participants have chosen to take a shorter race round the island Anholt. With a race for appx. 130 NM participants will be challenged on distance and sailing skills, but still be able to fit the race in a busy calendar.

Be aware that documents can be updated until Wednesday, June 15th at 8pm. Keep an eye on the <u>Noticeboard</u>, where changes will be announced. Please contact the race bureau if you need translation from Danish notifications.

Violation of rules provided to you by Elsinore Yacht Club can have consequences for your participation in the race.

We also present a broad variety of activities on shore this year, both for sailors and other interested persons. Meet our sponsors in the race village and greet the participants in the tent while you enjoy food from Marienlyst Strandhotel. There will be entertainment on the stage and some fortunate sailors might end up winning some of many prices. Look for information on https://sjaellandrundt.dk/program/.

If you did not already purchase this year's Round Sealand T-shirt for your crew it is possible to do so in the Race Village.

The number of prizes is extra-large this year with prizes worth more than 200.000 Dkr. Prizes will be distributed amongst race winners, lotteries and fortunate sailors. If you are present during lotteries and the prize ceremony prizes may be even better.

Please join us in the Race Village first time on Wednesday and again on Thursday morning. At the skipper meeting we will draw winners for prizes from some of the main sponsors. So, be there – you might be the lucky one. Finally, there will be a draw during the prize ceremony on Saturday 7.30 PM. If you are still sailing and not able to participate you are still part of the lottery and might get extra motivation to complete the race.

Arrival to Elsinore habour, Nordhavn



Instructions given by the port supervision and Round Seeland Officials must be followed.

Violation of this will constitute a breach of the sailing instructions.

Entry into port

Be respectful and use the engine at both entry and exit and offer a tow to boats without engine if possible. Fishing boats are located at the end of some bridges, do not dock alongside these.

Location of boats and port facilities

Your boats will have no special berths, but berths with green signs can be used freely. Boats with draft more than 3.5m please refer to 'Kulturhavn Kronborg' (ferry harbor) in central Elsinore.

Port dues and harbour office

Boats on the participant list can berth for 7 days without charges in the period between Friday June 10th and Monday June 20th (in the morning). A red label can be picked up at the harbour office and located on the boat as receipt for free habour fees. If the boat is in the harbour for more than 7 days regular guest fee will apply. Please use the automats for fees. If you leave your boat without crew before or after the race, the Port Control must be notified by email: havnevagten@havnevagten.dk or by telephone: +45 25 31 10 80. Only contact by telephone, no texts please.




Fig. 1. Helsingør north bassin. Click here or on the map to open pdf version.

The washing machines is located at the toilet building opposite the harbour office.

WiFi

Free WiFi on the entire habour. WiFi is named differently depending on the location. Try to find the best possibility. Password is not needed.

Fuel

Fuel is available at the end of the center pier.

Registration

Hand out of the TracTrac unit is regarded as confirmation that the boat will start and participate in the race. If not handed out before the start time the boat is regarded DNS, Did Not Start.

No documents will be distributed. Please make sure you print relevant documents beforehand.

Sailor's information, Notice Of Race, Sailing instructions and Description of courses must be present on the boat. Electronic versions are acceptable.

Please, bring logbook and completed crew list in a paper copy. It is also possible to send crew list electronically ahead of registration.

Skipper meeting

All races: Thursday June 16th 8:30AM on the Race Village Stage.

VHF information

Thursday morning it is mandatory to listen to VHF canal **72** before and during the start. Elsinore Yacht Club will provide relevant information using VHF. It as mandatory to follow start procedures. Do only listen to this channel and do only reply if you are asked to do so individually.

Please read notifications of changes on the official Noticeboard for Round Sealand and Anholt Race.

Tracking

TracTrac device is distributed at the registration when the race bureau has received the crew list. Follow all or a specific boat via tracking on <u>http://tractrac.com</u> or on the TracTrac app.

TracTrac is a tool for measuring times any doubts. Please make sure the tracker is safely mounted outside and 2 m. above the water surface to ensure the best signal.

Do never shut off or restart the unit manually. If the tracker shuts down during the race, please contact the bureau by phone +45 2654 8494.

I you lose the tracker, or the tracker no longer is visible on tractrac.com or the TracTrac app, it is very important that you register the time for when you cross the finish line. The tracker can lose signal in some parts of the route. However, the tracker will still collect data and will update once it gets a signal.

Sponsors

Duty to report

Participants must hand in the completed logbook and the TracTrac device to the race bureau as soon as possible after finish and <u>no later than one hour</u> after crossing the finish line.

If you abandon the race you must return logbook and TracTrac device as soon as possible and no later the Sunday June 19th 3PM.

Control on the racecourse

All participating vessels are authorized to record violations of sailing instructions. Damage incurred during the assistance from SR-official boats will not be compensated.

INSPECTION w.r.t. CERTIFICATE/CLASS OF PROOF FOR RACING BOATS

All race boats (with certificates) must after finish enter Helsingør Nordhavn and be available for possible inspection. Boats that are too big to enter and dock at the Helsingør Nordhavn is referred to Helsingør Kulturhavn (the ferry harbor). Inspection will be conducted by authorized surveyors.

Both that are hailed for testing in Helsingør Nordhavn shall dock at 'Midtermolen' unless otherwise advised.

Remember that all sails aboard must be measured and stamped or have 'sail button' under current rules (stamps must be visible).

It is the captain's responsibility that the boat comply with the Certificate.

Club membership

The captain participating in the racing class must be member of a sailing club approved by the Danish Sailing Association (or by the boats own national sailing association).

Race time limit

The Round Seeland weekend finishes at 15:00 Sunday 19th of June. All boats that completes after this time limit will be registered DNF (Did Not Finish).
