Arctic Waters and Greenland are high on the public agenda these days. To provide insights into the challenging maritime operation, as well as requirements for military presence and defense of Greenlandic territorial sea, we have invited two very knowledgeable persons to join us on the 29th of April 2025.

Allan Idd Jensen is heading a division in the “Danish Hydrographic Office” (Geodatastyrelsen), which he joined in 2016 after 19 years in Royal Arctic Line. Besides, he has acted as Chairman of the Polar Code Group in the Danish Shipowners Association.

Allan will give us an introduction to the challenges for ships, when operating in Greenland waters.

Torben Ørting Jørgensen is a former Danish Rear Admiral with a distinguished career in the Royal Danish Navy, including being stationed at NATO’s headquarter in Norfolk, USA. Torben is today chairman of the Danish defence and preparedness organization Folk og Sikkerhed. In this role, he actively contributes to public discourse on the missions and development of Denmark’s defence.

Torben will give us an overview of the present maritime defence capacities in Greenland and what is required for the future.

After the presentations, there will be time to network and as usual, there will be sandwiches and drinks.
