
Guidelines (Hidden slide)

- Header font should be Norwegian, other text should be Arial.





Migrating OneDrive for Business to OneDrive for Business

Follow these best practices when running a OneDrive for Business to OneDrive for Business migration.

Make sure your users and their OneDrive for Business exist in your destination


Sharegate doesn't migrate the users, it will search for the available users at the destination, and then migrate the data from the source OneDrive to the destination OneDrive for that user. So the users must be provisioned in the destination Active Directory before anything else is done.

Once the users are in your destination Active Directory, you'll need the OneDrive for Business provisioned for each one of them. If you don't know how to do this, you can consult this article: https://technet.microsoft.com/en-ca/library/dn800987.aspx

You can also provision all destination OneDrive for Business using this Sharegate Powershell cmdlet:
