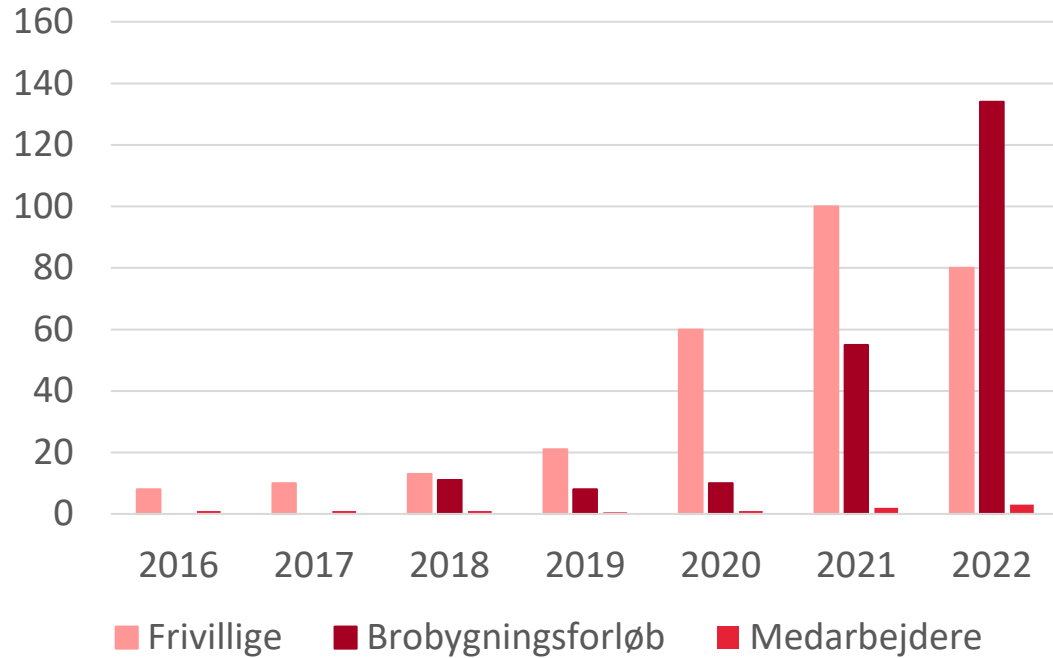

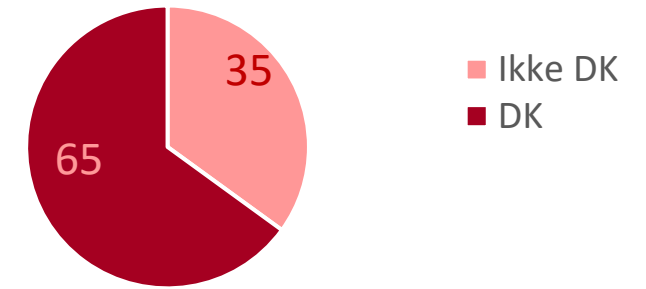

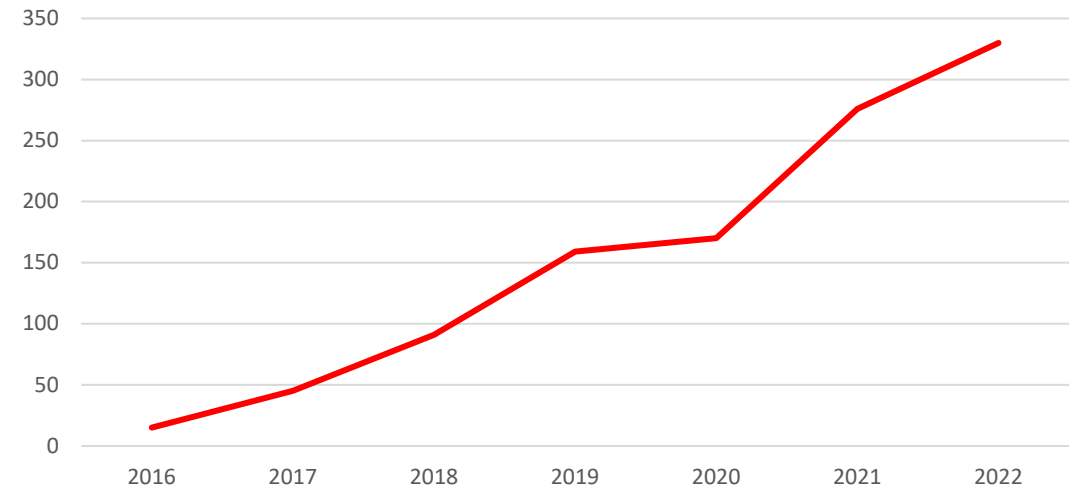
Active per year

Beretning Brobyggingstrappen

Specialsport.dk's 5 steps to sports and association life for all children and families with special needs and disabilities



Security & 'mirroring'

The most important thing of all is to create an awareness of sports in the parents.

Create recognition that sport is an opportunity also for their child.



Choices and options

There must be easy access to knowledge about the possibilities e.g. through the Guides.

At the same time, there must be an ongoing source of inspiration and reminder about sports, which is why repeat publications are necessary throughout school hours.



Match advice

Is there a club with only one exit? Is there a football team with only 4-5 other children? My child will play handball but has OCD and will not share the ball with others. Can he do that?

YES to it all



Handheld Help

Often it helps to match expectations of very small things with the club that transport is difficult or that the economy challenges.

'We do what it takes' and help with volunteering, bridge building and practical solutions.



Outreach efforts

Focus on non-association active students and to create separate courses involving both associations and parents.

These include sports internships, school taxi schemes or sports-home conversations.

The target is 80% association-active children and young people with special needs and disabilities in Denmark

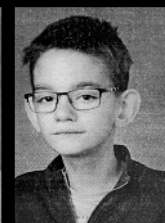

We only charge for support memberships at DKK 50 per year, as well as the possibility to support with a grant of DKK 200 annually.

Future

2021 was a year of strong professional and (slightly less) economic growth. The coming year will be just as exciting if not even more so.

- We are in the process of applying to the Egmont Foundation for participation in their Sprout Program
- We are in the process of expanding Specialsport Guides to North Jutland, Regions Zealand and Bornholm
- We are developing a new Web portal that can be accessed from all over Denmark and from abroad.
- We are conceptualizing the effort to initiate Sports internships at special schools.
- We are in the early beginning of some exciting new collaboration surfaces with LEV and the Department of Sport Analysis.
- We are in the process of establishing partnerships in Finland (Finnish Special Olympics), Hamburg (Evangelische Stiftung Alsterdorf) and Austria (BICI) – perhaps with the possibility of EU funding.
