It was too sad for words. No income anymore for all my friends who were already scraping money together day by day because of the high taxes. Sri Lanka was lost. I could not do anything as all schools closed and when finally, the primary schools opened their doors again, I left the country. I do really hope that tourists (sorry, no backpackers) will come back to this beautiful island and enjoy and spend some money here.

If this was not enough the election will take place on November 16th (so now).

Everybody is frightened. Everybody keeps money (if they have any) if their pockets. Less money is spent on charity/sponsoring.

Parents and schools are begging for more help. I have been helping this country for in the last 18 years, but I can't say it is getting better, I can say it is getting worse.

The government doesn't help education. Well this is not completely true; it helps the huge schools where their children go to school.

The former government gave shoes to children of remote schools, but this government hasn't done anything for the last 5 years.

Ramani told me a true story about a politician she met during one of her visits to a school. They had a chat and he told her that it would be better if they would work together to achieve more.

He told her if she gives her money to him, he would make sure it would go to the needy schools. Of course, Ramani said no.
