Objective

This patient summary means to discuss key recommendations from the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons (AAOS $^{\mathscr{O}}$) for Management of Osteoarthritis of the Knee (Non-Arthroplasty). It is limited to adults 18 years of age and older and should not be used as a reference for children.

Overview

- Osteoarthritis (OA[®]) is a progressive, degenerative condition leading to pain and loss of joint function.
- There are no known causes for OA® beyond wear and tear from ageing.
- Symptoms include pain and limitation of motion.
- This patient summary focuses on non-surgical management of osteoarthritis as it affects the knee joint.

Treatment

Recommended treatments include:

- Topical NSAIDs
- Oral NSAIDs
- · Supervised exercise, unsupervised exercise, and/or aquatic exercise
- Self-management
- · Patient education
- Sustained weight loss

Allowed treatments include:

- Canes
- Braces
- · Supplements:



- Turmeric
- Ginger extract
- Glucosamine
- o Chondroitin
- Vitamin D
- Neuromuscular training (i.e. balance, agility, coordination programs)
- Manual therapy (as performed by osteopaths and physical therapists)
