Rescue & provide homes for disadvantaged saplings & those that may die due to resource competition.

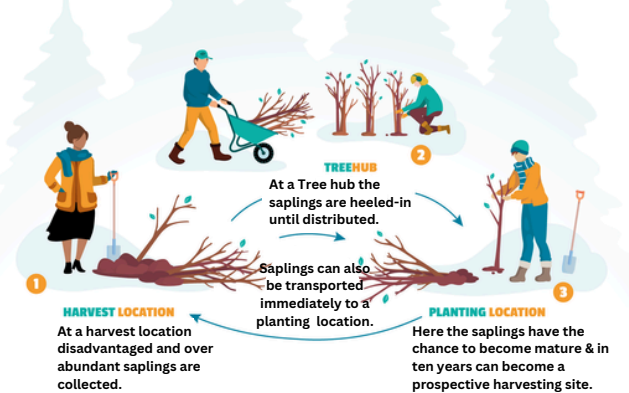


Together we can make a better world



A local solution for infinite scaling

Planting millions of trees is needed to fight the climate and biodiversity crises. The 'More trees now' method, provides a quick social, ecological and economically viable solution.



More Trees Now, is a Dutch campaign which began in 2020 and has been adopted since 2023 in more European countries. Thousands of volunteers in winter collect tree saplings and shrubs from places where they grow in abundance, unable to reach maturity or will be mowed. Harvesting is only done with permission from the forester or landowners.

These plants from **mother nature's nursery** are harvested and stored temporarily in 'hubs' before being donated to farmers, land owners and citizens to be planted.

In 3 seasons with **12,000 volunteers** in The Netherlands & Germany we transplanted **1.6 million trees .**
