



DOMESTIC STUDENTS STUDYING OVERSEAS

Apply to study an Undergraduate Program

Regardless of previous country of study or qualification, Australian citizens, Australian permanent residents, and New Zealand citizens are considered 'domestic' students for the purposes of admission to The Australian National University (ANU).

WHEN TO APPLY

Applications for the Semester 1 intake close in December* of the preceding year through UAC.

Applications for the Semester 2 intake close in April* of the same year.

WHAT IT WILL COST

As a domestic undergraduate student, you will enrol as a Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP) student, this means your fees will be subsidised by the Australian Government. You will only pay a student contribution which is determined by the Australian Government each year. The contribution will vary depending on the courses you take. WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?

When applying to attend the ANU, you will need to meet the academic admissions requirements, as well as the English Proficiency Requirement. The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma, GCE A Levels, among many other international qualifications from around the world are accepted as assessable for admission into ANU. Please note, for students completing IB (November session) or Australian Year 12, you will need to also meet the Co-curricular and Service Requirement.
