

How to apply - Domestic Overseas Student

An Australian domestic student is

- an Australian citizen;
- an Australian permanent resident (holders of all categories of permanent residency visas, including humanitarian visas), or
- a New Zealand citizen.

1. Choose your course

Choose your preferred course at uwa.edu.au/study and check that you satisfy your chosen course's admission requirements.

2. Apply online

As a domestic overseas-based student, you have two options on how to apply to UWA.

Apply Directly to UWA

1. Create a profile in [UWA Apply](#) and log in to get started
 2. Select your course, entry pathway and upload supporting documents
 3. Save or submit your application

Application dates

Applications for most courses open 2 years prior to the start date*. It is recommended that students submit all applications no later than 4 weeks prior to the intended start date of their chosen course.

**Please note this differs for Medicine, Dentistry, Podiatric Medicine and Pharmacy applications.*

Semester 1: Commences last week of February

Semester 2: Commences last week of July

Application documents

We require official documents to support your application with colour scans of the following:

- Passport identification page
- Academic transcripts
- English Language results

We do not require personal statements or letters of recommendation.

A Level Results

If you have A Level results, you must upload both your A Level final certificates and your GCSE (O Level) and AS Level (if any) final certificates (or equivalent). If you're currently studying A Levels, upload your GCSE and AS Level (if any) final certificates and your predicted A Level results at the time you apply, and then your final results as soon as they're available.

International Baccalaureate Diploma Results

If you have IB Diploma results, please upload this with your application. If you are currently sitting the IB Diploma, please provide your predicted results and then your final results as soon as they're available.
