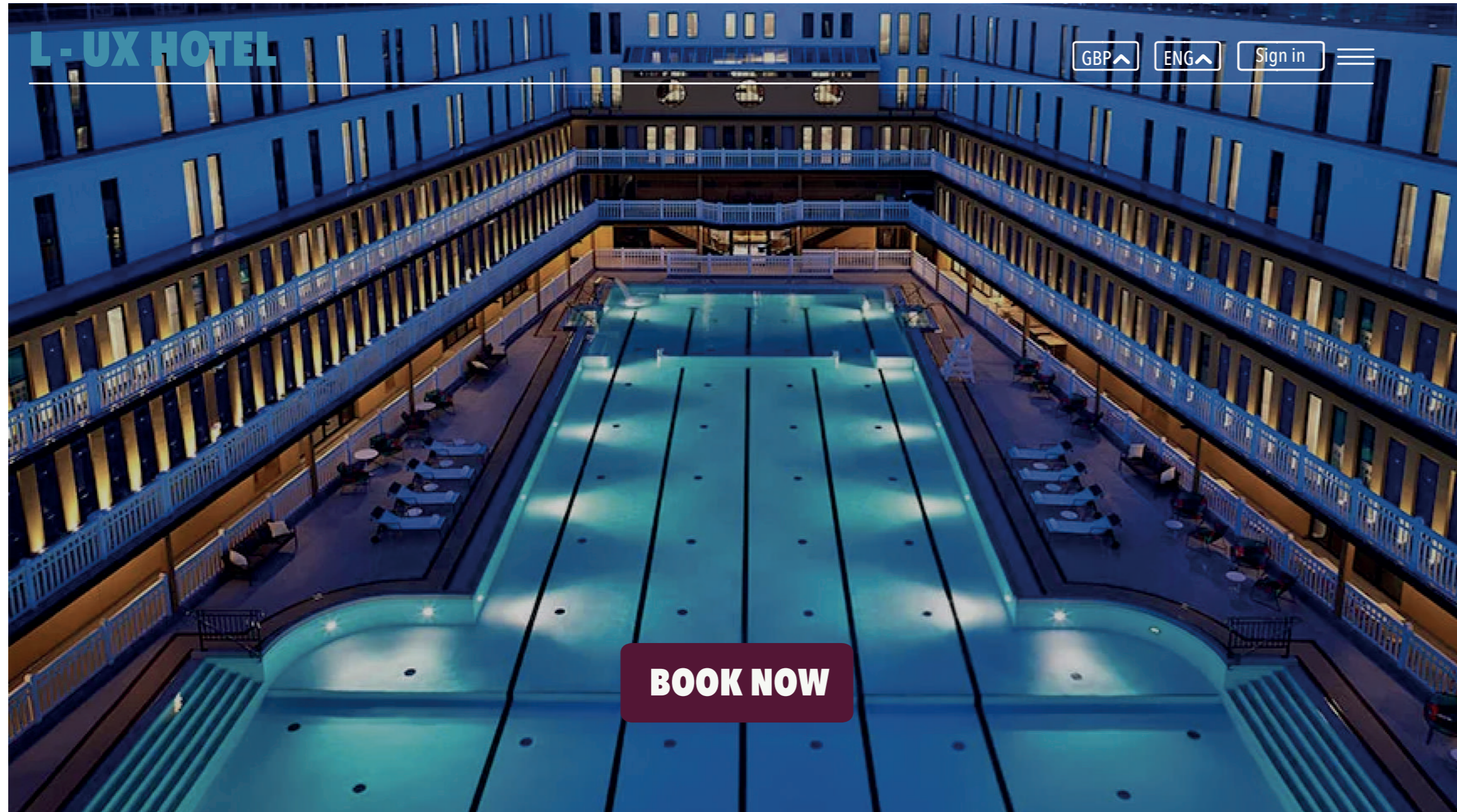



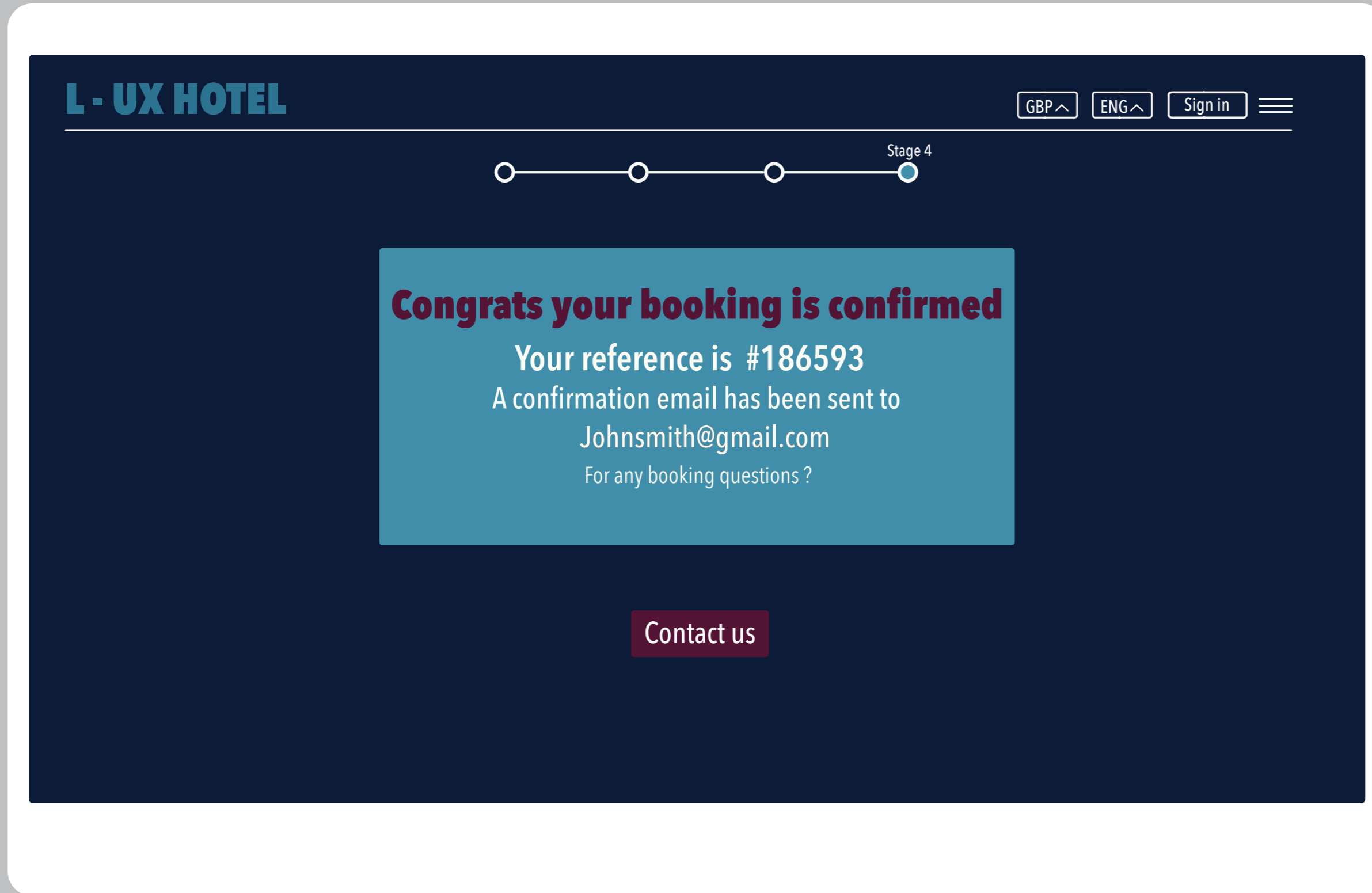
The *Payment page* starts when the user click the on the *text box to select state*, take away hint text, the user can then type in required text. The field will be validated once the user leaves the field or clicks enter to continue. *Each text box will be highlighted automatically* to make the flow easier to follow. When putting in the credit card details. *format the numbers so they chunk format* should follow *xxxx-xxxx-xxxx-xxxx* for credit and debt cards and for american express *xxx-xxxxxx-xxxxxx*. The field is validated when the cursor leaves the field. if the field is invalid then an error appears when. Not enough digits have been entered. *Error message: Not enough digits have been entered please try again* or when the card number entered is invalid, *Error message: The card number is not recognised please try again*. When the users enters the first 4 digits of the card the card will be recognised, once recognised show matching card type in field. card type only shown when matching digits have been entered. *The expiry date* shows a hint of the format until the users starts to type. With the *security code* there is a *small question mark icon* which can be clicked which will show a *small tool tip* to explain how to find the security number on the card.
