Tracks are finally been laid

After months of delay the first rails are laid in the streets of Wombat Creek

After Mr. Alfred Campbell, Mayor of Wombat Creek, announced in his New Year speech the arrival of a tramway system for our great town, the citizens have waited in suspense for the first signs of progress.

Towards the end of May the track laying finally commenced. With unprecedented speed two points near the War Memorial and the entire track loop around the future Tram Depot were put down in just one day.

Before a test run is done the surface of East Street will not be re-established, which will be a major obstacle for the general traffic. Access to the War Memorial Park is also restricted.

Further one working tram from the American company "Brill" has already arrived in Wombat Creek and put into storage. Wombat Creek Tramways now have two trams in working condition and with the arrival of a former double-decker tram from London four trams in non-working order.

The New Zealand contingent will represent the best rifle shots of that country and it is expected that high scoring will mark the three stages of the 1950 King's Prize.
