Show photographer is Anna Archinger Photography. Photos can be bought after the show. The price for all pictures per back number is 500 DKK. Single photos can be purchased Commercial photography only allowed in agreement with DKQHA. Please note that Kumlegaard QH is a private facility.

OFFICIEL PHOTOGRAPHER:

There will not be any livestream or video service at the Friday warm up show.

ENTRY:

Entry form is found here. When the entry form is submitted, the

show secretary will send an invoice to the horse owner. The invoice must be paid before the entry deadline.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRY:

20th of June 2024.

OFFICE FEE:

150 DKK (20 EUR) per horse.

STABLE:

The stable will be either tent box or permanent stables.

Box price DKK 450,- (EUR 60), including straw bedding. The stall is available from Thursday 16:00 to Friday evening. Additional DKK 100,-/EUR 14 if you stay until Saturday.

Stalls are allocated on a "first come, first served" principle. Please note your stable preferences on the entry form. It is possible to share a stall. This is not managed by DKQHA, but you can use our Facebook page to arrange it.

We can only guarantee boxes for entries received and paid no later than 20.06.2024.

Extra shaving can be purchased on the showgrounds during the show for DKK 150,-/EUR 20 per pack.

If the horse is entered in the European Team Cup, there is no additional stall fee.

ARRIVAL:

Arrival from Thursday at 16:00. The arenas are open from 17:00.

HAY:

Kumlegaard QHs sells hay and wrap. It can be purchased directly from Kumlegaard QHs during the show.

CAMPING:

DKK 350,-/EUR 47 Thursday-Saturday including electricity DKK 250,/EUR 34- Thursday-Saturday without electricity Camping sign can be collected in the show office and must be visible on the caravan/tent.

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PAYMENT:

After submitting your entry form, you will receive an invoice from the show secretary. The invoice must be paid to one of the following solutions:

MEMBERSHIPS:

We ask all exhibitors to make sure that all memberships are in order before the show. Please note that membership in AQHA **must** be purchased before the show starts.

You must be an amateur/youth member to be able to enter the AQHA Amateur/Amateur L1 (Youth/Youth L1) classes.

A copy of exhibitors AQHA membership must be attached to the entry form.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES:

By submitting a vet- or doctors' certificate no later than 1 day after the show, the entire entry fee is refunded. Stable and office fee will not be refunded.

RIBBONS AND PRICES

Top 6 under each judge will be announced and receive a ribbon.

AQHA RULES

The show is AQHA-approved. The show is held by the rules of AQHA.

VACCINATION:

All the horses must have valid vaccination according to the Danish rules.

RULES IN THE WARMUP AND SHOW PEN

In the warmup a horse cannot be closer than two meters from the barrier, when performing a sliding stop. A violation will cause a yellow card to the rider.

In the warmup the horse cannot perform more than eight spins in a row. A violation will cause a yellow card to the rider.

NB! Equipment, which according to the AQHA rulebook, are illegal cannot be used under warm up or training. This includes martingales, tie-downs and draw reins. A violation will cause a yellow card to the rider.

In case the rider breaks the rules after receiving a yellow card, the show manager can decide to give the rider a red card. This means suspension from the show. In case of suspension entry fees will not be repaid.

Numbers must always be worn visible when riding and/or longing on and around the show area.

LUNGING

Lunging is allowed in both arenas, except from when the show is running. Lunging is permitted until half an hour before the show starts every day.

We refer to the roundpen and outdoor arena.

ETHICS

Inhuman treatment of the horses on the show ground will cause suspension from the competition and suspension from the show ground. Video and photography might occur. All riders must respect each other and show regard to each other in the stall and in the arenas.

CAFETERIA

The cafeteria is open from 10:00-18:00 and sells various drinks and snacks, such as french-fries, chocolates, toasts, and popcorn. Coffee and tea are available from early morning.

DISCLAIMER

All activities on the show ground are your own responsibility. When entering the show, you accept responsibility for every risk and accepting you are responsible for your own animals, persons, and belongings.

Dogs must always be kept in leash.

Smoking in all the buildings is not allowed. It includes stables, arenas, cafeteria, and toilets.
