



## LIVING COSTS IN GERMANY

The total monthly average expenses of a student in Germany are between 700 and 1.200 Euro

Average monthly expenses for rent: 350 - 750 €
Average monthly expenses for insurance: 35 -115 €
Average monthly expenses for food: 250 - 350 €
Average monthly expenses for Tel. &Int:: 40 - 60 €
Average monthly expenses for transports and others: 50 - 150 €



# REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDYING IN GERMANY



#### **REQUIREMENTS FOR BACHELOR'S DEGREE**

All applicants with high school diploma which is **similar** the German university entrance qualification wants to Study Bachelor degree in Germany do not need freshmen (Studienkolleg)

All applicants with high school diploma which is different from the German university entrance qualification and who wants to Study Bachelor degree in Germany need freshmen year (Studienkolleg)

Direct access to the university without studienkolleg: Studying one or two year study at a university

### **MASTER'S CONDITIONS**

English programs	Course language 100 % in English •Requirements (English program) GPA over 3 from 4 •Toefel over 79 (Internet Based) or IELTS over 6.5 •German Level: A1 or till B1
	•GRE test is strongly recommended
German programs	Course language 100% in German •Requirements GPA over 2,1 from 4 •German Level: DSH II or DSH III
Double Language Programm	Course language 70% English and 30% German. •IELTS over 6.5 or Toefl over 80 (Internet Base) • GPA over 2,8 from 4 •German Level: A2- B2
