WWSC Workshop

The conference WWSC Workshop is arranged two times per year (early summer and early winter). This is the large centre-wide event to which all members are invited and expected to participate.

At the WWSC Workshops, presentations and discussions around the activities within the center are combined with prominent guest lectures and activities for PhD students and postdocs.

WWSC Academy

All PhD students funded by WWSC 3.0 are enrolled in the graduate school WWSC Academy. In two week-long courses per year, the students get broad knowledge of topics relevant for the field and in site visits get an overview of the Swedish forest industry.

During the WWSC Academy courses students connect with each other to nurture future collaborations. Participation in the courses is compulsory for WWSC PhD students.

WWSC Annual report

Bibliometry

Treesearch

Treesearch is a collaboration platform for research on new materials from the forest for researchers in academia, industry and institute. Via Treesearch researchers can get access to advanced characterizarion techniques and expertise.

The Swedsih industry is co-funding WWSC via Treesearch, and WWSC is the core of the research activities in the platform.

Knut and Alice Wallenberg Foundation (KAW)

The Knut and Alice Wallenberg Foundation (KAW) is the largest private financier of research in Sweden and one of the largest funding bodies in Sweden. The generous donation from KAW is the basis for WWSC since 2009 and lasts until 2028.
