Hello 'Runners'

'In a nutshell route notes' in case you get lost. But, just follow the car in front and you should be fine!

1. Leave Ballabona and head for La Concepcion and Zurgena - AL7106
2. Turn left into Zurgena and drive through the village to Arboleas - AL7104
3. At Arboleas, keep close contact with group as we go through lots of twists and turnings.
4. We arrive at, and take the new motorway A334 and turn in the direction of Albox / Baza.
5. At junction 70 come off for Almanzora - AL7102.
6. Drive through Almanzora and on to Cantoria - A1100, driving through the old railway yard, again keep close company with group.
7. After Cantoria, we head in the direction of Albox and cross over the A334, turning off into the service area on the second roundabout. You can see the closed petrol station and cafe.
8. After coffee take the A399 to Partaloo, Oria and Chirival. Its a straight road with no turning off.
9. After Chirival services, keep close company from here to the monastery.

If you run out of petrol (it happens) last car has a petrol can, just wait for help.
