Join us for a discussion about where Bahrain stands in regards to the implementation of UPR recommendations, wherein panelists will speak about Bahrain's continued failure to implement the recommendations made in its Second Cycle UPR. It has been nearly two years since Bahrain accepted 158 of 176 recommendations made by member States of the UNHRC, and the Government of Bahrain has yet to fully implement even one recommendation. As a result, Bahrain has failed to address issues relating to labor and women's rights, its criminal justice system, media and press freedom, and restrictions on human rights defenders. Instead of addressing these concerns, the Government of Bahrain has continued with the status quo, thereby leaving major political and human rights challenges unresolved.
