Al-Wefaq: Sectarian Oppression Deprives Students of Scholarships

The Al-Wefaq Society said that Baharna families in Bahrain are feeling "anger and resentment" because of what their academically outstanding sons and daughters are going through. Their children are being "deprived of scholarships because of the sectarian oppression that they are subjected to by authorities."

The organization added that "scholarship distribution is one of the issues in which Bahraini people are suffering from an obnoxious sectarian oppression that works to fight against ambition and hope."

Al-Wefaq explained that students with scores higher than 98% were deprived from scholarships, while others did not get their desired majors, because of the sectarian oppression that governs life in Bahrain.

Al-Wefaq confirmed that the "continuation of the appointed government, lack of accountability, and ongoing unilateral governance subjects the distribution of scholarships, employment services, and other aspects of life to sectarian oppression and discrimination, which is a crime against this nation."
