

Security Forces Put Karranah under Siege, Raid Houses, and Arrest Dozens

Security forces launched a wide campaign of house arrests in Karranah after the explosion on 28 August. According to the Ministry of Interior, the explosion resulted in the death of one policeman and the injury of others.

Local sources stated that security forces arrested more than 20 persons from Karannah. Security forces put the area under siege with military vehicles and deployed checkpoints at the entrances of the area. Large numbers of militias and security forces were seen raiding houses and terrorizing people. Citizens confirmed the assault of individuals and theft of many items during the raids.

Karannah is still under siege and security forces are stopping residents and passersby. Yousif Khalil Ebrahim was arrested after security forces surrounded his car when he was with his wife and two daughters, all of whom were left in the street. In addition, several were arrested from King Fahad Causeway on their way to Ehsa'a.
