



REQUEST FOR ACCESS TO INTERPOL'S DATABASES

The Commission for the Control of Interpol's Files will only act on your request if the conditions concerning admissibility are met

Conditions concerning admissibility

To allow the Commission to examine whether your request is admissible, you must provide:

- An original letter,
 - duly signed
 - sent by post solely to the Commission
 - written in one of INTERPOL's four working languages (Arabic, English, French, Spanish).
- A copy of an identity document for the person who is the subject of the request.
- If you are representing the person who is the subject of the request: a power of attorney (original) signed by the person concerned, expressly authorizing you to exercise his/her right of access (including for correction) to INTERPOL's files.
- For requests to correct information in INTERPOL's files:
 - the reasons for your request including, if appropriate, a summary of your arguments in one of INTERPOL's four working languages,
 - any document necessary to support your request in one of INTERPOL's four working languages so that the Commission may take the documents into consideration.
- For requests concerning a minor, also provide:
 - a copy of an identity document for you,
 - a copy of any document proving your relationship with the minor.

Reasons for the request and list of documents supporting the request:

Compulsory for requests to modify or delete information
