Next year's session will be one of the highlights of our Museum's 60th anniversary celebrations. The exact date and programme of the celebrations will be announced at a later date.

During the Conference, on 25.09.2024, there will be a study trip to our Branch - the Jaracz Museum of Milling and Waterworks.

The conference fee of PLN 900 (205€) includes two nights' accommodation (i.e. 24/25.09.2024 and 25/26.09.2024), meals and the conference resources, including the conference programme and abstracts of the presentations; in the case of your own accommodation, the fee is PLN 600 (135€).

We plan to publish the papers submitted and the communications in the form of a scientific monograph. Speakers will additionally receive 2 copies of the conference proceedings. The deadline for the submission for publication of finished papers is 15 March 2024. For publishing reasons, it is essential that we receive the texts by the above deadline.

I sincerely hope that the planned Conference, like its previous editions, will contribute to the integration of activities for the protection of the common national heritage.
