ALGARVE BIKE CHALLENGE 2023

The Algarve Bike Challenge is a demanding yet rewarding 3-day stage race. With a fresh new route each edition, it's a great test of endurance, resolve and skill with the staggering beauty of the Algarve's sunshine landscape set as the perfect antidote to the physical and mental demands of off-road racing. Twoperson teams, top elite riders and ambitious amateurs alike, explore the seemingly endless, amazing trails, staying overnight in double rooms in Tavira by the sea – an unforgettable Portuguese experience!

Team members can be of different age and gender and have to ride together all the time in order to be classified.

Teams will race under a specific regulation available on the race official website. This is a timed race with 3 days duration that includes a Night Prologue and 2 Marathon Stages covering a total of 160Km extension. Along the marathon stages multiple feeding areas sponsored by GoldNutrition and control points will be available to support the riders.

Besides the ideal conditions to race, this course offers panoramic views over the Algarve's coast that will delight the riders.

In terms of organisation, Associação Clube BCF will be the responsible of all the technical and logistics issues of this event, course definition, food and drinks supply, safety, accreditation, promotion of the event and for all the necessary infrastructures.

VERY IMPORTANT: The participants should know their race number which can be checked on the Race Entry List. Personal identification such as passport or UCI 2023 License should be presented at the Race Office and the signed Statement of Responsibility.

The Race Office will take place on the March 10th from 11:00 to 18:00 at the Mercado da Ribeira, in the city centre close to the Start and Finish area. At the Race office, it will be delivered the Race Kit, identifying number to be placed in the front of the bike and identifying bracelet for the athlete with the contacts of the assistance and emergency.

Stages Start: At the city center in front of the Municipality building – Praça da República

Stages Finish on Saturday and Sunday: At the city center in Rua José Pires[®] Padinha.

Once again in 202e the riders will have the possibility to store a bag with warm clothes on an identified tent at the paddock area in front of the old market. Please do not leave any valuable items as the organisation will not be responsible for lost items.

Bikes should be stored at the Bike Parks which are supervised 24 hours a day by an accredited Security company.

Bikes are not allowed on the bedrooms of Vila Galé Hotels and Maria Nova. Any bike seen inside the bedrooms will be taken by the hotel management and the organisation have no responsibility over them.

To have access to the Bike parks, the bike must have the participant's number well placed on the handlebar and its rider must have the bracelet identifying the corresponding team's number. To collect a bike from a bike park only the rider with the corresponding number and letter can take the bike. The Organisation will not be responsible for any kind of loss or robbery in Vila Galé Hotels or inside the Paddock.

Please note that on Sunday 12th after 4pm all bike parks will be closed and dismantled so all the bikes must be out of the bike parks before 4pm. Please ask hotel reception to store your bike.

Bike Wash: There will be a bike wash available at the Paddock and another located in the other side of the river in front of the Galp Gas Station.

Podium: The athletes that are subject to the prize giving ceremony should present themselves with the jersey and race shorts of the team and sports shoes

Teams Logistics: The teams and staff can have their logistics at Jardim Municipal or at Praça da República. This logistics should be auto-sufficient and assure the safety of their own structures. The organisation will not be responsible for any damages or robberies occurred.

Feeding and drinking Area after stages 2 e 3: The organisation will serve a Pasta Party in the end of each stage to the athletes. It includes a soup, cold salads, fruit, cakes, water and juices. This Pasta Party is not included for the companions and/ or Staff of the teams. On the day of the Prologue, the organisation will not serve any parcel of food to the participants. There are several restaurants in the centre of the city.





PADDOCK ALGARVE BIKE CHALLENGE

The paddock area of the Algarve Bike Challenge is located at the Jardim Público de Tavira and Mercado da Ribeira, close to Gilão river, in Tavira city center.

Concerning the Algarve Bike Challenge organisation, several services were allocated to serve the participants needs.

In front of Mercado da Ribeira (accreditation place) you will find the official Algarve Bike Challenge store as well as other promotional stands from the event partners and suppliers.


THE ROUTE - DETAILS AND LOCATIONS

1st Stage - March 10th 2023 - Night Prologue - 2,5 Km

The use of night lights in the prologue is mandatory. White front light and red rear light. 3 teams start every minute.

Teams that don't start in the Prologue will be allowed to continue on the race although they will be credited with the time of the last team classified on the night prologue plus 20 minutes penalty.

There will be a pre-call to the Prologue 5 minutes before each start to improve the access to the start point. All teams must respect this asset.





11th AND 12th OF MARCH 2023 - Stage 2 and Stage 3- IMPORTANT INFO

START GRID (BOX)

GRID 1 - Top 10 of the General Classification - Grid Opening at 08:15
GRID 2 - 11° to 49° of the General Classification - Grid Opening at 08:15
GRID 3 - 50° to 99° of the General Classification - Grid Opening at 08:15
GRID 4 - 100° to 150° of the General Classification - Grid Opening at 08:30
GRID 5 - 151° to 214° of the General Classification - Grid Opening at 08:30

Teams must be in their starting Box up to 5 minutes before the starting time. In case that does not happen, the team will start integrated in the last grid. The leaders of each category must be in the podium area at **08:30am** of day 2 and 3 for the podium ceremony.

The race uses normal paved roads, crosses towns and villages and occasionally uses trails in private land. Racers must take in consideration that none of the roads or trails will be closed to other users. Racers may encounter vehicles, animals and people circulating in either direction on the race course.

In order to promote the racers security in these situations you will find visible signage (STOP) and a crew member to control the traffic. In some intersections, there will be police officers controlling the crossing. Participants must keep always on right side and respect the Portuguese traffic regulations.

Algarve Bike Challenge 2023 will be guided by Gps but some areas will be marked on the course with ribbons and signs.

The tracks and Gps maps will be sent to the e-mails informed at the online subscription of the race. In case the user does not receive this information by e-mail should contact the organisation.

During the event, tracks will not be loaded on Gps devices. If you have troubles uploading them to the device please contact the organisation in advance.



Along the course, organisation will set several control points which will not be revealed. Any team that doesn't pass by all these points will not be considered to the Classifications. Both team members have to ride together along the course. Penalties will be applied if this rule is not respected. The penalty will be 5 minutes per 1 minute of delay.

At the Feed Zones the riders will find water, isotonic drinks, gums, fruit and cakes. Basic mechanical service will be also available as well as lube service.

For safety reasons the riders have a limit time to pass at the Feed Zones. All riders arriving a Feed Zone after the defined limit time informed ahead on this Race Book will be considered out of the Race and will not be allowed to continue in the course. The Organisation will provide car transportation for these riders and their bikes to the Start / Finish area.

During both stages, several streams will be crossed. Some of them will be very slippery and can be dangerous so we <u>strongly recommend</u> caution in these points.

The Organization intends to respect the environment as much as possible, so it will only be possible to leave any type of garbage on the ground in the identified Feed Zones. Any athlete who is detected leaving litter in other areas of the course, the respective team will be penalized in 60 minutes for each mentioned action.

Technical details of Stage 2

- Distance from the Start to the Feed Zone 1: 27km 880mt of climbing;
- Distance from the Feed Zone 1 to the Feed Zone 2 20Km 435mt of climbing;
- Distance from Feed Zone 2 to Feed Zone 3 18 km 400mt of climbing;
- Distance from Feed Zone 3 to the Finish Line: 19km 255mt of climbing;

In order to provide an easier and safe start of the marathon stages the first kms of the stage will be in tarmac roads. For the 2nd stage it will be a 7km tarmac section until the place called Pego do Inferno

This section will be lead by the police so the roads will be closed to the traffic and exclusive to the race. After the km 7 only the road intersections will have police control and the gravel intersection will have organisation marshals.

The advice the riders to have extreme caution in the downhill at km 41 due to the steepness and tight bends.






Stage 2 - Feed Zone 3 Map







STAGE 3 - 12th March 2023 - Cacela Trails

This is the only section of the stage where the riders of the duo can distance themselves. In this timed section, between km 50.5 and 55, individual prizes will be awarded to the fastest male and female elements, with an offer of **1 Gps Garmin 830 device.**
