

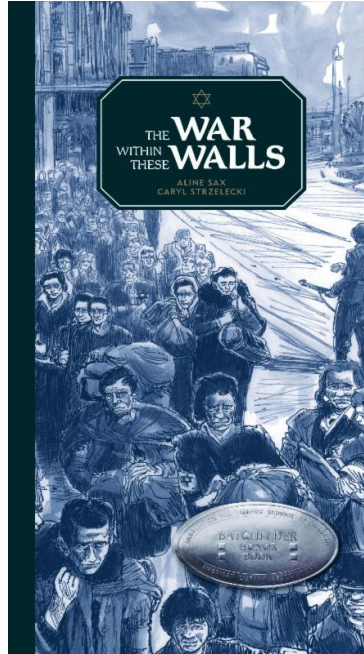


Flanders Inspires, Flanders Intrigues

Misha struggles to help his family survive, but when conditions worsen he joins a handful of other Jews in a final, desperate stand against the Nazis.
