Objectives:

The central theme of the 2021 European Parliament Romani week Western Balkans session focuses on the importance of employment, as a key element for breaking the circle of exclusion.

Roma community's access to employment remains one of the major challenges and a clear barrier for sustainable inclusion. Data show that the rate of unemployment of Roma is well beyond the national average and that an important share of the existing employment is in the informal market. Initiatives targeting employment in the public sector, improvement of employment offices approach to reach Roma population or address employment discrimination, delivered limited results. More needs to be done and new approaches pursued. In the context, the Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance has started supporting a project to address entrepreneurship in the Western Balkans.

During the session, panellists will discuss the importance of supporting and developing the right skills and build capacity of Roma entrepreneurs with the view to have them actively contribute to the recovery of the Western Balkans economies, and to the implementation of the European Investment Plan for Western Balkans (COM 2020/641 final of 6 October 2020).

The objective of this session is to present the innovative "Roma entrepreneurship approach" already tested in some Member States and Western Balkans economies, to share experience of beneficiaries and to show-case reference examples.
