

Forward calendar

12 Christmas ornaments

The seams are always done on the right side of the gugus in blanket stitch. Seams are included

Snowman:

Close the round of the man keeping the bottom open, stuff lightly with fleece and continue your seam to close the round.

Sew 2 mini black pearls for the eyes.

Embroider a cross for the nose and knots for the mouth = black embroidery cotton Sew the jacket on both sides and the top of the sleeves. !!! Fold the collar over to catch it in your seam.

Thread on the snowman and secure with a button.

Cut a 0.5mm / 4cm strip from the green felt.

Place it on the top of the head and hold it with two buttons at the ears.

Here is his earmuff

Glue the two small beads for the hands.

Lick on the back.

Norwegian elf

Sew 2 triangles on top of each other. Make 2 X

Superimpose these two sets and secure with a button.

Close the hat in the round.

Cover a large bead with raffia = the head

Secure the cap on the head as well as in the back of the pixie after the body.

Lick on the back.

The angel

Make the body as for the snowman.

Overlap and sew the wings.

Attach them to the back.

Glue the head and wool for the hair.

Embroider 3 stars at the bottom of the front.

Lick on the back.

Birdhouse

Sew around.

Fill with fleece through the central hole.

Close the hole.



Close the top of the roof.

Place it on the top of the nest box and secure with small dots.

Sew a button for the bird stand.

Lick on the back.

Head of Santa Claus

Close around the beard, keeping the top open, stuff with a little fleece.

Fold the bottom of the cup like the dotted lines outwards. Close around the cap, keeping the bottom open by pinching the fold, stuffing with fleece.

Place the cap on the beard and make a front stitch to secure the two together.

Glue a large bead in the hole, draw the eyes, glue the mustache.

Embroider a cross with gold cotton on the front of the hat.

Sew a mini bell at the end of the hat.

Lick on the back.

Mittens

Fold the top along the dotted lines outward.

Close the round, keeping the top open, stuffing with fleece.

Glue a mini tree on one side. Make a blanket stitch around to secure it.

Make a second mitten.

Connect them with a piece of +/- 20 cm of red pearl cotton.

Gingerbread Man

Close the tour, keeping an opening along the leg.

Stuff with fleece, continue to close the tower.

Sew two mini black beads for the eyes.

Bell

Close the round keeping the bottom open.

Stuff with fleece.

Glue two mini sheets on one side.

Make a few knots to represent the berries.

Secure 15 cm of gingham tape in a stream.

Take a bite.

Head of Santa Claus:

Sew around the head and stuff with fleece before closing completely.

Apply the beard on one side. Close the hat in the round and apply it on the head.

Embroider eyes and nose. Sew the star button on the hat and the bell on the tip.

Tie the back with embroidery cotton.



Christmas ornament:

Sew around and stuff with fleece before closing completely with red cotton.

Embroider the star in the center.

Tie the back with embroidery cotton.

Snowflake:

Superimpose the two flakes, the white on top.

Embroider in front stitch to secure the two sets.

Tie the back with embroidery cotton

Star:

Sew around and stuff with fleece before closing completely.

Embroider eyes and mouth.

Tie the back with embroidery cotton
